



## General Information

The quantities of yarn are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. It is essential to work to the stated tension and you should always knit a tension square before starting. If you have too many stitches to 10cm/4in your tension is tight and you should change to a larger needle. If there are too few stitches, your tension is loose and you should change to a smaller needle.

We cannot accept responsibility for the finished product if any yarn other than the one specified is used.

Instructions given are for the first size, with larger sizes in round brackets. Where only one size is given this applies to all sizes. Work all directions in square brackets the number of times stated.

When working with random dyed yarn, to avoid a sudden jump in colour when starting a new ball, start at a similar place in the colour shading.

See ball band for washing and pressing instructions.

# Hooded Coat

## MEASUREMENTS

## MATERIALS

1150(1250:1350)g of Noro Iro in shade 26.  
Pair each of 6mm(US 10) and 6½mm  
(US 10½) knitting needles.  
4 wooden toggles.

## TENSION

14 sts and 20 rows to 10cm/4in square over  
patt using 6½mm(US 10½) needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**kpk** = knit, purl, knit all into next st.  
Also see page 6.

## BACK

With 6mm(US 10) needles cast on  
73(93:113) sts.

**Moss st row** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

This row forms moss st and is repeated 3  
times more.

Change to 6½mm(US 10½) needles and work  
in patt as follows:

**1st row** (right side) K1, \* p1, k9; rep from \*  
to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

**2nd row** K1, p1, [k9, p1, k1, p9] 3(4:5) times,  
k9, p1, k1.

Rep the last 2 rows 6 times more.

**15th and 16th rows** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

**17th row** As 1st row.

**18th row** K1, p1, [k9, p1, k1, p9] 3(4:5)  
times, k1.

Rep the last 2 rows 6 times more.

**31st and 32nd rows** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

These 32 rows form the patt.

Cont in patt until back measures  
68(69:70)cm/26¾(27¼:27½)in from cast on  
edge, ending with a wrong side row.

**Next row** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

This row forms moss st and is repeated.  
Work 1 row.

## Shape armholes

Cont in moss st and cast off 6 sts at beg of  
next 2 rows. 61(81:101) sts.

Work straight in moss st until back measures  
89(91:93)cm/35(35¾:36¾)in from cast on  
edge, ending with a wrong side row.

## Shape shoulders

Cast off 9(13:16) sts at beg of next 4 rows.  
Leave rem 25(29:37) sts on a holder.

## LEFT FRONT

With 6mm(US 10) needles cast on 37(47:57)  
sts.

**Moss st row** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

This row forms moss st and is repeated 3  
times more.

Change to 6½mm(US 10½) needles and work  
in patt as follows:

**1st row** K1, [p1, k9] 3(4:5) times, [p1, k1] 3  
times.

### 1st and 3rd sizes only

**2nd row** K1, [p1, k1] 3 times, [p9, k9, p1, k1]  
1(2) times, p9, k1.

### 2nd size only

**2nd row** [K1, p1] 3 times, [k9, p1, k1, p9]  
twice, k1.

### All sizes

Rep the last 2 rows 6 times more.

**15th and 16th rows** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

**17th row** As 1st row.

### 1st and 3rd sizes only

**18th row** [K1, p1] 3 times, [k9, p1, k1, p9]  
1(2) times, k9, p1, k1.

### 2nd size only

**18th row** [K1, p1] 3 times, [k1, p9, k9, p1]  
twice, k1.

### All sizes

Rep the last 2 rows 6 times more.

**31st and 32nd rows** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

These 32 rows form the patt.

Cont in patt until front measures 68(69:70)cm/26¼(27¼:27½)in from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

**Next row** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

This row forms moss st and is repeated.

Work 1 row.

#### **Shape armholes**

Cont in moss st and cast off 6 sts at beg of next row. 31(41:51) sts

Work straight in moss st until front measures 85(85:86)cm/35(35:35½)in from cast on edge, ending with a right side row.

#### **Shape neck**

Cast off 4(5:6) sts at beg of next and foll alt row, then 3(4:6) sts at beg of next alt row.

Moss st 1 row.

Dec one st at beg of next row. 18(26:32) sts.

Cont straight until front measures same as Back to shoulder, ending with a wrong side row.

#### **Shape shoulder**

Cast off 9(13:16) sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

#### **RIGHT FRONT**

With 6mm(US 10) needles cast on 37(47:57) sts.

**Moss st row** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

This row forms moss st and is repeated 3 times more.

Change to 6½mm(US 10½) needles and work in patt as follows:

**1st row** (right side) [K1, p1] 3 times, [k9, p1] 3(4:5) times, k1.

#### **1st and 3rd sizes only**

**2nd row** K1, [p9, k1, p1, k9] 1(2) times, p9, [k1, p1] 3 times, k1.

#### **2nd size only**

**2nd row** K1, [p9, k1, p1, k9] twice, [p1, k1] 3 times.

#### **All sizes**

Rep the last 2 rows 6 times more.

**15th and 16th rows** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

**17th row** As 1st row.

#### **1st and 3rd sizes only**

**18th row** K1, p1, k9, [p9, k1, p1, k9] 1(2) times, [p1, k1] 3 times.

#### **2nd size only**

**18th row** [K1, p1, k9, p9] twice, [k1, p1] 3 times, k1.

#### **All sizes**

Rep the last 2 rows 6 times more.

**31st and 32nd rows** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

These 32 rows form the patt.

Complete to match Left Front, reversing shapings.

#### **SLEEVES**

With 6mm(US 10) needles cast on 27(29:31) sts.

**Moss st row** K1, [p1, k1] to end.

This row forms moss st and is repeated.

Work 3 rows.

Change to 6½mm(US 10½) needles.

Cont in moss st, inc one st and each end of the 5th and every foll 4th row until there are 67(69:71) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 48(48:50)cm/19(19:19½)in from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Cast off 5(6:6) sts at beg of next 6 rows.

Cast off rem sts.

#### **HOOD**

Join shoulder seams. With right side facing and 6mm(US 10) needles pick up and k18 sts up right front neck, moss st across 25(29:37) sts at centre back neck, pick up and k18 sts down left front neck. 61(65:71) sts.

Work in moss st until collar measures 14cm/5½in, ending with a wrong side row.

**Next row** Moss st 18 sts, kpk, moss st 25(29:37) sts, kpk, moss st to end.

Work 3 rows.

**Next row** Moss st 20 sts, kpk, moss st 25(29:37) sts, kpk, moss st to end.

Cont in moss st until hood measures 32(33:34)cm/12¼(13:13½)in, ending with a wrong side row.

Cast off in moss st.

#### **TO MAKE UP**

Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeve top to shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams. Join top seam on hood. Sew on toggles to left front, the top one 1cm/½in below beg of neck shaping with the other three at 15cm/6in intervals. Make yarn loops on right front edge for toggles.
