



## General information

The quantities of yarn are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. It is essential to work to the stated tension and you should always knit a tension square before starting. If you have too many stitches to 10cm/4ins your tension is tight and you should change to a larger needle. If there are too few stitches, your tension is loose and you should change to a smaller needle.

We cannot accept responsibility for the finished product if any yarn other than the one specified is used.

Instructions given are for the first size, with larger sizes in round brackets. Where only one size is given this applies to all sizes. Work all directions in square brackets the number of times stated.

# Lattice and Cable Sweater in Iro

## MEASUREMENTS

## MATERIALS

1200(1300:1300)g of Noro Iro in shade 53.  
 Pair each of 6mm(US 10) and 7½mm  
 (US 11) knitting needles.  
 6mm(US 10) short circular knitting needle.  
 2 cable needles.

## TENSION

19 sts and 16 rows to 10cm/4in square  
 over cable and rib panels using 7½mm  
 (US 11) needles.  
 25 sts of large lattice cable panel measure  
 13cm/5in wide.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**C3B** = slip next st onto cable needle and  
 hold at back of work, k2, then p1 from  
 cable needle.  
**C3F** = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle  
 and hold at front of work, p1, then k2 from  
 cable needle.  
**C4B** = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle  
 and hold at back of work, k2, then k2 from  
 cable needle.  
**C4BP** = work as C4B, but p2 from cable  
 needle.  
**C4F** = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle  
 and hold at front of work, k2, then k2 from  
 cable needle.  
**C4BF** = work as C4F, but p2, then k2 from  
 cable needle.  
**C5B** = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle  
 and hold at back of work, k2, return 3rd st  
 on cable needle to left needle and hold  
 cable needle to front, p1, then k2 from  
 cable needle.  
**C5F** = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle  
 and hold at front of work, slip next st onto  
 2nd cable needle and hold at back of  
 work, k2, then p1 from 2nd cable needle,  
 then k2 from 1st cable needle.  
**m1p** = lift strand between sts and p into  
 back of it.  
 Also see page 4.

## NOTE

When working with random dyed yarn, to  
 avoid a sudden jump in colour when  
 starting a new ball, start at a similar place  
 in the colour shading.

**Small lattice cable panel** (worked over  
 17 sts)

**1st row** (right side) P2, k2, p2, C5F, p2,  
 k2, p2.  
**2nd and every wrong side row** K and p  
 sts as they appear.  
**3rd row** P2, [C3F, C3B, p1] twice, p1.  
**5th row** P3, [C4B, p3] twice.  
**7th row** P1, C4BP, C3F, p1, C3B, C4FP,  
 p1.  
**9th row** P1, k2, p3, C5F, p3, k2, p1.  
**11th row** P1, C4FP, C3B, p1, C3F, C4BP,  
 p1.  
**13th row** As 5th row.  
**15th row** P2, [C3B, C3F, p1] twice, p1.  
**16th row** As 2nd row.  
 These 16 rows form the patt and are  
 repeated.

**Rib and cable panel A** (worked over 13  
 sts)

**1st row** (right side) K2, p2, C5B, p2, k2.  
**2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th rows** P2, k2, p2,  
 k1, p2, k2, p2.  
**3rd, 5th and 7th rows** K2, p2, k2, p1, k2,  
 p2, k2.  
 These 8 rows form the patt and are  
 repeated.

**Rib and cable panel B** (worked over 13  
 sts)

**1st row** (right side) K2, p2, C5F, p2, k2.  
**2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th rows** P2, k2, p2,  
 k1, p2, k2, p2.  
**3rd, 5th and 7th rows** K2, p2, k2, p1, k2,  
 p2, k2.  
 These 8 rows form the patt and are  
 repeated.

**Large lattice cable panel** (worked over 25 sts)

**1st row** (right side) [P2, k2] twice, p2, C5F, p2, [k2, p2] twice.

**2nd and every wrong side row** K and p sts as they appear.

**3rd row** P2, k2, p2, [C3F, C3B, p1] twice, p1, k2, p2.

**5th row** P2, C3F, p2, C4B, p3, C4B, p2, C3B, p2.

**7th row** P3, C3F, C3B, C3F, p1, C3B, C3F, C3B, p3.

**9th row** P4, C4F, p2, C5F, p2, C4F, p4.

**11th row** P2, C4BP, C3F, C3B, p1, C3F, C3B, C4FP, p2.

**13th row** P2, k2, p3, [C4B, p3] twice, k2, p2.

**15th row** P2, C4FP, C3B, C3F, p1, C3B, C3F, C4BP, p2.

**17th row** As 9th row.

**19th row** P3, C3B, C3F, C3B, p1, C3F, C3B, C3F, p3.

**21st row** P2, C3B, p2, C4B, p3, C4B, p2, C3F, p2.

**23rd row** P2, k2, p2, C3B, C3F, p1, C3B, C3F, p2, k2, p2.

**24th row** As 2nd row.

These 24 rows form the patt and are repeated.

## BACK

Using 6mm(US 10) needles, cast on 118 (126:134) sts.

**1st row** (right side) K2, [p2, k2] to end.

**2nd row** P2, [k2, p2] to end.

These 2 rows form the rib.

Rib 7 more rows.

**Dec row** (wrong side) Rib 22(26:30), k2tog, rib 14, k2tog, rib 18, k2tog, rib 18, k2tog, rib 14, k2tog, rib 22(26:30).

113(121:129) sts.

Change to 7½mm(US 11) needles.

**1st row** (right side) Rib 14(18:22), work 17 sts of 1st row of small lattice cable panel, 13 sts of 1st row of rib and cable panel A, 25 sts of 1st row of large lattice cable panel, 13 sts of 1st row of rib and cable panel B, 17 sts of small lattice cable panel, rib 14(18:22).

This row sets the position of cable panels with rib at each side.

Work 59 more rows, so ending with 12th rows of both small and large lattice cable panels.

## Shape armholes

Cont in patt as set. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec one st at each end of next 9 rows. 91(99:107) sts. \*\*

Work 27(31:31) more rows, so ending with 2nd(6th:6th) row of large lattice cable panel.

Cast off.

## FRONT

Work as given for Back to \*\*.

Work 15 more rows, so ending with 14th row of large lattice cable panel.

## Shape neck

**Next row** (right side) Patt 35(39:43) sts, turn and work on these sts only for left side of neck.

[Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row and dec one st at end of foll row] 4 times. 23(27:31) sts.

Work 3(7:7) rows.

Cast off.

With right side facing, slip centre 21 sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem 35(39:43) sts, patt to end.

[Dec one st at end of next row and cast off 2 sts at beg of foll row] 4 times. 23(27:31) sts.

Work 3(7:7) rows.

Cast off.

## SLEEVES

Using 6mm(US 10) needles, cast on 46(54:54) sts.

Rib 9 rows as given for Back.

**Dec row** (wrong side) P2, [k2, p2] 0(1:1) time, k2tog, rib 18, k2tog, rib 18, k2tog, p2, [k2, p2] 0(1:1) time. 43(51:51) sts.

Change to 7½mm(US 11) needles.

**1st row** (right side) Inc one st by purling into first st in row below, rib 0(4:4), C5B, p2, k2, work 25 sts of 1st row of large lattice cable panel, k2, p2, C5F, rib 0(4:4), inc one st by purling into last st in row below. 45(53:53) sts.

This row sets the position of rib and cable panel A, large lattice cable panel and rib and cable panel B. Working invisible incs as given and taking inc sts into rib and cable panels A and B, then into rib, cont in patt as set and inc one st at each end of every 4th row until there are 75(83:83) sts. Patt 1 row, so ending with 14th row of large lattice cable panel.

## Shape top

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Dec one st at each end of next 10 rows, so ending with 2nd row of large lattice cable panel. 51(59:59) sts.

Cast off.

## COLLAR

Join shoulder seams, matching sts.

With right side facing, using 6mm(US 10) circular needle, k up 50 sts across back neck and 20(24:24) sts down left front neck, at centre front work k2, p2, k2tog, skpo, p2tog, p1, k2tog, skpo, p2tog, p1, k2tog, k1 across 21 sts on holder then k up 20 sts up right front neck. 104(112:112) sts.

**1st round** [P2, k2] to end.

This round forms rib.

Rib until collar measures 25cm/9<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>in.

Cast off in rib.

### **TO MAKE UP**

Do not press. Sew in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams.



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Instructions given are for the first size, with larger sizes in round brackets. Where only one size is given this applies to all sizes. Work all directions in square brackets the number of times stated.

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# Lattice and Cable Sweater in Cash Iroha

## MEASUREMENTS

To fit bust	81-86	86-91	91-97	cm

## MATERIALS

500(550:600)g of Noro Cash Iroha in shade 61.

Pair each of 3¾mm(US 5) and 4½mm(US 7) knitting needles.  
3¾mm(US 5) short circular knitting needle.  
2 cable needles.

## TENSION

27 sts and 26 rows to 10cm/4in square over cable and rib panels using 4½mm(US 7) needles.  
25 sts of large lattice cable panel measure 9cm/3½in wide.

## NOTE

This garment is worked from the same instructions as the sweater in Iro with slight variations to the number of rows worked for the Back, Front and Sleeves. Where the Iro instructions give needle size 6mm(US 10), use 3¾mm(US 5), where Iro instructions say change to 7½mm(US 11) needles, change to 4½mm(US 7) needles throughout.

## BACK

Work as given for back of Iro sweater to \*\*. Work 39(43:43) more rows, so ending with 14th(18th:18th) row of large lattice cable panel.  
Cast off.

## FRONT

Work as given for front of Iro sweater to \*\*. Work 27 more rows, so ending with 2nd row of large lattice cable panel.

## Shape neck

Work as given for Iro sweater.

## SLEEVES

Using 3¾mm(US 5) needles, cast on 62(70:70) sts.

Rib 9 rows as given for Back.

**Dec row** (wrong side) P2, [k2, p2] 2(3:3) times, [k2tog, rib 18] twice, k2tog, [p2, k2] 2(3:3) times, p2. 59(67:67) sts.

Change to 4½mm(US 7) needles.

**1st row** (right side) Inc one st by purling into first st in row below, [k2, p2] 1(2:2) times, work 13 sts of 1st row of rib and cable panel A, work 25 sts of 1st row of large lattice cable panel, work 13 sts of 1st row of rib and cable panel B, [p2, k2] 1(2:2) times, inc one st by purling into last st in row below. 61(69:69) sts.

This row sets the position of the panels with rib at each side. Work invisible incs as given and taking inc sts into rib, cont in patt and inc 1 st at each end of every 4th row until there are 95(103:103) sts. Work 17 rows, so ending with 14th row of large lattice cable panel.

## Shape top

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec one st at each end of next 10 rows, so ending with 2nd row of large lattice cable panel. 71(79:79) sts.



Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 12 rows, so ending with 14th row of large lattice cable panel. 47(55:55) sts.  
Cast off.

### **COLLAR**

Matching sts, join shoulder seams. Using 3¾mm(US 5) circular needle, k up 50 sts across back neck and 20(24:24) sts down

left front neck, at centre front work k1, skpo, [p2tog] twice, k2tog, k1, p1, m1p, k1, skpo, [p2tog] twice, k2tog, k1 across 21 sts on holder, k up 20(24:24) sts up right front neck. 104(112:112) sts. Complete as for collar of Iro sweater.

### **TO MAKE UP**

Work as given for Iro sweater.
