

KIRI hat



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Depth: 8½" / 21.5cm

Brim circumference: 22" / 55.5cm

SKILLS

Level: Easy+

Needed: Working in the round, simple lace.

YARN & NOTIONS

MC: 1 hank Sabine in #09 Wisteria

CC: small amount Sabine in #01 Fettuccini

US 5 (3.75mm) and 7 (4.5mm) 16" / 40cm circular needles

US 7 (4.5mm) set of 4 or 5 double-pointed needles.

Adjust needle sizes to obtain correct gauge if necessary.

Stitch marker, tapestry needle.

Gauge: 19 sts and 30 rows = 4" / 10cm in St st with larger needle.



HAT

With smaller needles and CC, CO 108 sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist CO row; pm at beg of rnd.

Work in k1, p1 rib for 2 rnds. Change to MC and cont until ribbing measures 2" / 5cm.

Knit 1 rnd.

Inc rnd: (K3, m1) around until 3 sts rem and end with k3 - 143 sts.

Change to larger needles and k 1 rnd.

Begin lace patt (multiple of 11 sts)

Lace Rnd 1: *(K2tog) 2 times, (yo, k1) 3 times, yo, (k2tog) 2 times; rep from *

Lace Rnd 2: Knit.

Repeat Lace Rnds 1-2 until piece measures 6.5" / 16.5cm from CO row.

Crown decs (change to dpn when sts no longer fit around circular):

Rnd 1 and all odd-numbered rnds: Knit.

Rnd 2: (K9, k2tog) 13 times – 130 sts.

Rnd 4: (K8, k2tog) 13 times – 117 sts.

Rnd 6: (K7, k2tog) 13 times – 104 sts.

Rnd 8: (K6, k2tog) 13 times – 91 sts.

Rnd 10: (K5, k2tog) 13 times – 78 sts.

Rnd 12: (K4, k2tog) 13 times – 65 sts.

Rnd 14: (K3, k2tog) 13 times – 52 sts.

Rnd 16: (K2, k2tog) 13 times – 39 sts.

Rnd 18: (K1, k2tog) 13 times – 26 sts.

Rnd 20: (K2tog) – 13 sts.

FINISHING

Cut yarn. Use a tapestry needle to pull tail through remaining stitch loops, tighten and weave in tail neatly on WS. Gently wash and block.
