

COWSLIP
HAT AND SCARF



NATURALLY **NORO**

COWSLIP *hat*

MATERIALS

50g of Noro Silk Garden
(photographed in shade 203)
Pair of 5mm (US 8) knitting needles

TENSION

18sts and 24rows to 10cm/4ins square over st st using 5mm (US 8) needles

MEASUREMENTS

To fit small to average sized adult head

TO MAKE

With 5mm (US 8) needles, cast on 74sts.

1st row: k1 *k6 [p1, k1]3 times, p6, [p1, k1]3 times rep from * to last st, k1

2nd row (wrong side): p1 *[k1, p1]3 times, k6, [k1, p1]3 times, p6 rep from * to last st, p1

These 2 rows form the patt

Rep the last 2 rows until the hat measures 17cm/6³/₄ins from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

SHAPE CROWN

1st row (right side): k1 *k2togtbl, k2, k2tog, p2tog, [p1, k1]twice, p2tog, p2, p2togtbl, p2tog, [p1, k1]twice, rep from * to last st, k1 (56sts)

2nd row: k1, *[k1, p1]twice, k6, [p1, k1]twice, p4 rep from * to last st, p1

3rd row: *k6, [p1, k1]twice, p4, [k1, p1]twice rep from * to last 2sts, k2

4th row: as 2nd row

5th row: k1, *k2togtbl, k2tog, k1 [p1, k1]twice, p2tog, p2togtbl, k1, [p1, k1]twice rep from * to last st, k1 (44sts)

6th row: p1 *[k1, p1]twice, k4, [p1, k1]twice, p2 rep from * to last st, p1

7th row: *k4, p3tog, k1, p3, p3tog rep from * to last 2sts, k1, p1 (32sts)

8th row: p1, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, p3, k1, p1, k3, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, p3

9th row: k2tog, k1, p2tog, k1, p2tog, p1, p2tog, k2tog, k1, p2tog, p2tog, p1, k2tog, k2tog, k1, p2tog, p1, p2tog, k2tog, k1 (20sts)

10th row: k1, k2togtbl, *[k2tog, k2togtbl]twice, rep from * to last st, k1 (11sts)

Break off yarn. Thread through 11sts.

Pull securely and fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Sew up the side seam.



COWSLIP *scarf*

MATERIALS

• 250g of Noro Silk Garden (photographed in shade 203)
• Pair of 5mm (US 8) knitting needles

TENSION

18sts and 24rows to 10cm/4ins square over st st using 5mm (US 8) needles

MEASUREMENTS

25cm/10ins x 185cm/74ins

TO MAKE

With 5mm (US 8) needles cast on 45sts.

1st row: k1, [p1, k1]to end

This row forms the moss st patt. Rep last row five times more Starting with a knit row, st st for five rows.

Rep the last 11 rows until scarf measures 185cm/74ins (or desired length) ending with last row of moss st patt. Cast off.

BASIC INFORMATION

It is essential to work to the stated tension. This is especially important as some patterns can be followed using different yarns though of all the same tension, a tension square should be knitted before starting. A tension square should take an evening and ensures that the correct size is knitted resulting in a successful handknit.

If you have too many stitches to your 10cm/4in square, your tension is tight and you should change to a larger needle. If there are too few stitches, your tension is loose and you should change to a smaller needle.

Work all directions inside square brackets the number of times stated.

Cast off- bind off

Moss stitch- seed stitch

Tension- gauge

Stocking stitch- stockinette stitch
