back

With 5mm (US 8) needles, cast on 70(74:78:82:86)sts.

Starting with a knit row, cont in g st until back measures 35cm/13¾ins from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

shape armholes

Cast off 5sts at the beg of the next 2 rows. 60(64:68:72:76)sts

Dec one st at each end of next and 3 foll 4th rows. 52(56:60:64:68)sts

Cont without shaping in g st until armhole measures

22(22:24:24:24)cm/8¾(8¾:9½:9½:9½)ins from start of armhole shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

shape shoulders

Cast off 14(15:16:17:19)sts at the beg of the next 2 rows.

Leave centre 24(26:28:30:30)sts on a holder.

left front

With 5mm (US 8) needles, cast on 35(37:39:41:43)sts.

Starting with a knit row, cont in g st until left front measures 35cm/13¾ins from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.



Materials

1000(1100:1100:1200:1200)g of Patagonia
Pair of 5mm (US 8) knitting needles
open ended zip to fit

Tension

14sts and 24rows to 10cm/4ins square over st st using
5mm (US 8) needles

shape armhole

Cast off 5sts at the beg of the next row. 30(32:34:36:38)sts
Dec one st at armhole edge of next and 3 foll 4th rows.
26(28:30:32:34)sts
Cont without shaping in g st until armhole measures
18(18:20:20:20)cm/7(7:8:8:8)ins from start of armhole shaping,
ending with a **right side** row.

shape neck

Work 8(9:10:11:11)sts, slip these sts on a holder, knit to end.
Dec one st at the neck edge of next and every foll row until there
are 14(15:16:17:19)sts.
Cont without shaping in g st until armhole measures
22(22:24:24:24)cm/8¾(8¾:9½:9½:9½)ins from start of armhole
shaping, ending with a wrong side row.
Cast off.

right front

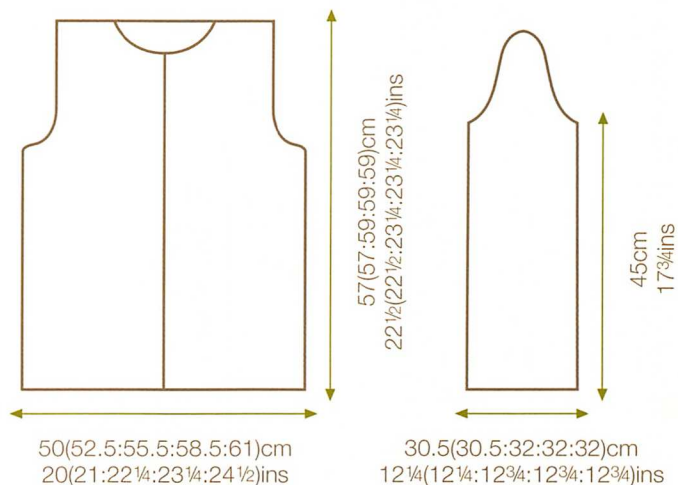
Work as given for left front, reversing shapings.

sleeves

With 5mm (US 8) needles, cast on 42(42:45:45:45)sts.
Starting with a knit row, cont in g st until sleeve measures
45cm/17¾ins from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape top

Cast off 5sts at the beg of the next 2 rows. 32(32:35:35:35)sts
Dec one st at each end of next and 4 foll 4th rows.
22(22:25:25:25)sts
Work 1 row.
Dec one st at each end of next and 3 foll alt rows.
14(14:17:17:17)sts
Work 3 rows.
Dec one st at each end of next and every foll row until
8(8:11:11:11)sts rem.
Cast off 3sts at the beg of the next 2 rows. 2(2:5:5:5)sts
Cast off rem sts.



hood

Join shoulder seams. With right side facing and 5mm (US 8) needles, knit 8(9:10:11:11)sts from holder at right front, pick up and knit 8sts up right front neck, knit 24(26:28:30:30)sts from holder at centre back, pick up and knit 8sts along left front neck, knit 8(9:10:11:11)sts from holder at left front. 56(60:64:68:68)sts
Starting with a knit row, cont in g st until hood measures 14cm/5½ins, ending with a wrong side row.

Next row: k16, m1, k1, m1, knit to last 17sts, m1, k1, m1, knit to end.

Work 3 rows.

Next row: k17, m1, k1, m1, knit to last 18sts, m1, k1, m1, knit to end.

Cont without shaping in g st until hood measures 35cm/13¾ins, ending with a wrong side row.

Cast off.

to make up

With right sides together, join cast off edges of hood. Join side and sleeve seams. Position and sew zip into place.
