

## FELTED BOLSTER

This cushion is suitable  
for a beginner knitter.



### FELTED BOLSTER

#### YARN

Ella Rae Classic

Colour	No.	Quantity x 100g balls
col A	14	1
col B	05	1
col C	06	1
col D	17	1
col E	12	1

#### MEASUREMENTS

##### Before felting:

52 cm x 52 cm

##### After felting:

Length 45 cm

Width 48 cm

#### NEEDLES

1 pair 4.50 mm needles (USA 7)(UK 7)

#### Cushion Filling

1 bolster insert, 45 cm in length x 48 cm circumference.

2 Tassels

#### TENSION

20 sts and 24 rows measured over 10cm (approx 4") of st st using 4.50 mm needles.

Using 4.50mm needles and col A, cast on 98 sts.

Work in st st as foll:

col A work 3 cm.

col B work 6 cm.

col C work 2 cm.

col D work 2 cm.

col B work 6 cm.

col C work 2 cm.

col E work 10 cm.

col C work 2 cm.

col B work 6 cm.

col D work 2 cm.

col C work 2 cm.

col B work 6 cm.

col A work 3 cm, ending on a WS row.

Cast off.

#### ENDS (make 2)

Using 4.50mm needles and col A,

cast on 90 sts.

St st 4 rows.

Row 5 \*K2tog, k1; rep from \* to end. (60 sts)

St st 3 rows.

Row 9 \*K2tog, k1; rep from \* to end. (40 sts)

P 1 row.

Row 11 \*K2tog, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1. (27 sts)

P 1 row.

Row 13 \*K2tog, k1; rep from \* to end. (18 sts)

P 1 row.

Row 15 \*K2tog; rep from \* to end. (9 sts)  
Break off yarn, leaving enough length to sew seam.

Thread yarn through rem sts and pull through to secure.

Sew seam using edge to edge st (see method pg 50).

#### MAKING UP

Double felt all pieces separately (see method pg 50).

Fold piece in half widthwise and sew seam to form a tube.

Sew one end into place, then insert filling and sew other end into place.

Sew a tassel to each end.
