


CHARLES

YARN Ella Rae CLASSIC HEATHERS





NEEDLES

1 pair 4.00mm needles (USA 6)(UK 8) 1 pair 4.50mm needles (USA 7)(UK 7)

1 4.00mm circular needle

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

1 x 18 cm zip

TENSION

17 sts and 20 rows measured over 10 cm of Rib Pattern using 4.50mm needles.

Rib Pattern

* K1, K1B; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2. Repeat this row throughout.

FRONT

Using 4.60mm needles, cast on 74(82,88) sts. Knit 1 row.

measures 26(28,30)om from beg. ending on a WS row. Shape armholes(RS) Cast off 3 sts at beg next 2 rows, [68(76,82) sts] Cont working straight until length measures 31(35,39)cm, ending on a WS row Divide zip opening(RS) Rib 34(38,41) sts. (RS) Cast off rem 8(9,9) sts. turn, leave rem sts on a holder. Work each side separately. Cont working straight until length measures 40(44,48)cm, ending on a RS row. Shape front neck and shoulder(WS) Cast off 4(5,6) sts, rib to end. (RS) Rib to last 2 sts, k2tog. (WS) K2tog, rib to end. Rep last 2 rows once more. (RS) Cast off 7(8,9) sts, rib to last 2 sts, k2tog. (WS) K2tog, rib to end. (RS) Cast off 7(8,9) sts, rib to last 2 sts, k2tog. (WS) K2tog, rib to end. (RS) Cast off rem 8(9,9) sts. With RS facing rejoin yarn to rem sts. Cont working straight until length measures same as left side of front to beg of neck shaping, ending on a WS row. measures 34(37,41)cm, ending on (RS) Cast off 4(5,6) sts, rib to end. (WS) Rib to last 2 sts, k2tog. (RS) K2tog, rib to end. Rep last 2 rows once more. (WS) Cast off 7(8,9) sts, rib to last 2 sts, k2tog. (RS) K2tog, rib to end. (WS) Cast off 7(8,9) sts, rib to last 2 sts, k2tog. (RS) K2tog, rib to end. (WS) Cast off rem 8(9,9) sts. BACK Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 74(82,88) sts. Knit 1 row. Cont working in rib pattern until length measures 26(28,30)om from beg. ending on a WS row.

Cont working in rib pattern until length

CHARLES continued Shape back neck and shoulders(RS) Cast off 7(8,9) sts, rib 21(24,26) sts, turn, leave rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately. (WS) Cast off 3(3,4) sts, rib to end. (RS) Cast off 7(8,9) sts, rib to end. (WS) Cast off 3(4,4) sts, rib to end.

With RS facing, leave 12 centre sts on a holder, rib to end.

Rejoin yarn to rem sts.

- (WS) Cast off 7(8,9) sts, rib to end. (RS) Cast off 3(3,4) sts, rib to end.
- (WS) Cast off 7(8,9) sts, rib to end.
- (RS) Cast off 3(4,4) sts, rib to end.
- (WS) Cast off rem 8(9,9) sts.

SLEEVES

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 30(32,34) sts. Knit 1 row. Cont working in rib patt AT THE SAME TIME shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st each end foll 7th rows, 6(6,6) times, then on foll 9th rows, 2(3,4) times. [46(60,64) sts 60(69,78) shaping rows] Cont working straight until length a WS row. Cast off.

MAKING UP

Press pieces gently on WS, using a warm iron over a damp cloth. Join shoulder seams. Join side seams. Sew sleeve seam. Centre sleeve into armhole and sew. Neckband With RS facing, using 4.00mm needles, pickup and knit 15(16,17) sts up right front neck shaping, 8(9,10) sts along back neck shaping, 12 sts from holder at back neck, 8(9,10) sts along rem side of back neck, 16(17,18) sts down left front neck shaping. [69(63,67) sts] Work 18cm in k1, p1 rib, ending on a WS row. Cast off in rib. Fold collar in half to inside. Sew along neck edge to secure. measures same as front to sh sh, ending Insert zip and sew into position.

Please note: Some Ella Rae yarns, such as Amity and Amity Heathers have been discontinued. Please feel free to substitute Ella Rae Classic and Ella Rae Classic Heathers.

Shape armholes(RS) Cast off 3 sts at

beg next 2 rows. [68(76,82) sts]

Cont working straight until length

on a WS row.
