



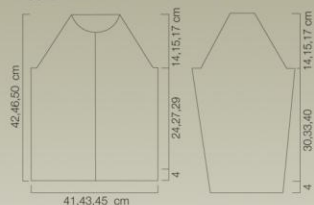
## BRADLEY

### YARN

### NEEDLES

- 1 pair 4.50mm needles (USA 7)(UK 7)
- 1 pair 5.00mm needles (USA 8)(UK 6)

### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

6 Buttons

### TENSION

18 sts and 24 rows measured over 10cm of St st using 5.00mm needles.

### BACK

Using 4.50mm needles and col A, cast on 74(78,82) sts.

(RS) K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

(WS) P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form rib patt.

Work 4cm in rib, ending on a WS row, inc 0(2,2) sts on last row worked.

[74(80,84) sts]

Change to 5.00mm needles.

Cont working in St st until length (incl band) measures 16(19,21)cm, ending on a WS row.

Change to col B.

(RS) Knit.

(WS) Purl.

Refer to graph on page 46 for colour changes and pattern placement, work 19 graph rows.

(WS) Using col B, purl.

(RS) Using col B, knit.

(WS) Using col B, purl.

### BRADLEY continued

Change to col A.

Cont working in col A and St st for remainder, work straight until length measures 28(31,33)cm, ending on a WS row.

**Shape raglan armholes(RS)** Cast off 4 sts at beg next 2 rows. [66(72,76) sts]

Next row(RS) K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, sl 1, k1, pss0, k2.

(WS) Purl.

Rep last 2 rows, 16(19,21) times more. Cast off rem 32 sts.

### LEFT FRONT

Using 4.50mm needles and col A, cast on 36(40,44) sts.

(RS) \* K2, p2; rep from \* to end.

(WS) \* K2, p2; rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form rib patt.

Work 4cm in rib, ending on a WS row.

Change to 5.00mm needles.

Cont working in St st until length (incl band) measures 16(19,21)cm, ending on a WS row.

Change to col B.

(RS) Knit.

(WS) Purl.

Refer to graph for colour changes and pattern placement, work 19 graph rows.

(WS) Using col B, purl.

(RS) Using col B, knit.

(WS) Using col B, purl.

Change to col A.

Cont working in col A and St st for remainder, work straight until length measures 28(31,33)cm, ending on a WS row.

**Shape raglan armholes(RS)** Cast off 4 sts at beg next row. [32(36,40) sts]

(WS) Purl.

(RS) K2, k2tog, k to end.

Rep last 2 rows, 10(11,13) times more.

[21(24,26) sts]

**Shape neck(WS)** Cast off 5(6,8) sts, p to end. [16(18,18) sts]

(RS) K2, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog.

(WS) P2tog, p to end.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. [4(6,6) sts]

(RS) K2, k2tog, k0(2,2) sts. [3(5,5) sts]

(WS) P2tog, p1, p0(2,2)tog. [2(3,3) sts]

Cast off rem sts.

### RIGHT FRONT

Work as for left front, reverse all shapings.

### SLEEVES

Using 4.50mm needles and col A, cast on 36(40,44) sts.

Work 4cm in k2, p2 rib as for fronts,

ending on a WS row, inc 1st at end last row worked. [37(41,45) sts]

Change to 5.00mm needles.

Cont working in St st, AT THE SAME TIME **shape sides** as foll:

Inc 1 st each end next row, then 1 st each end foll 10th rows, 6(3,3) times, then 1 st each end foll 14th rows, 0(3,3) times.

AT THE SAME TIME when 47(51,57) sts and 42(52,66) rows have been worked, change to col B.

(RS) Knit.

(WS) Purl.

Next row(RS) K15(17,20) sts, refer to graph for colour changes, work 17 sts from graph, k to end.

(WS) P15(17,20) sts, work 17 sts from graph, p to end.

These 2 rows set patt placement.

Cont as set working inc's into sts at sides until 19 graph rows have been worked.

(WS) Using col B, purl.

(RS) Using col B, knit.

(WS) Using col B, purl. Cont working in col A and St st for remainder, after all inc's have been worked, work straight until length measures 34(39,44)cm, ending on a WS row. [51(55,59) sts]

**Shape raglan(RS)** Cast off 4 sts at beg next 2 rows. [43(47,51) sts]

(RS) K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, sl 1, k1, pss0, k2.

(WS) Purl.

Rep last 2 rows, 16(19,21) times more.

[9(7,7) sts] Cast off rem sts.

### MAKING UP

Press pieces gently on WS, using a warm iron over a damp cloth.

Join raglan sleeves to front and back.

Join sleeve and side seams.

**Collar** Using 4.50mm needles, col A and with RS facing, pickup and knit 78 sts evenly along neck edge.

(WS) P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

(RS) K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form rib patt.

Cont working in rib until length measures 12cm, ending on a WS row. Cast off in rib.

### Front bands

**Right Band(Buttons)** Using 4.50mm needles, col A and with RS facing, pickup and knit 60(68,76) sts along right front beg at cast on edge and ending at neck edge, pickup 30 sts along collar to cast off edge. [90(98,106) st]

(WS) K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

(RS) P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. Cast off in rib.

Mark positions for 6 buttons, the first to be placed approx 1cm from cast on edge, the last to be placed approx 1cm below neck edge, the other 4 to be spaced evenly between.

**Left Band(Buttons)** Using 4.50mm needles, col A and with RS facing, pickup and knit 30 sts along collar to neck edge, 60(68,76) sts along left front from neck edge to cast on edge. [90(98,106) sts]

(WS) P2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

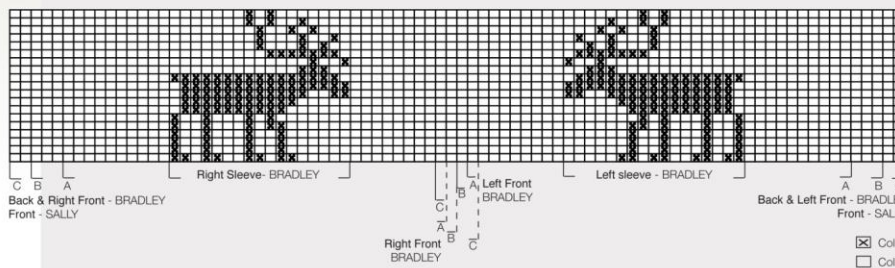
(RS) K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

Work WS row again.

**Buttonhole row(RS)** Make buttonholes to correspond with button placements as foll: yf, k2tog, rib to next placement, rep until 6 buttonholes are made, rib to end. Work 2 more rows in rib.

Cast off in rib.

Sew buttons to right band.
