

## Lontué Macramé Scarf

Finished measurements: 12" x 66" (including fringe)

Materials: 2 skeins Lontue by Araucania

Size 5 US needles

Gauge: irrelevant

Cast on 52 sts. Knit 8 rows.

Row 1: k3, \*[(yo, k2tog) 7x, k2], repeat from \*, (yo, k2tog) 7x, end k3.

Row 2: k3, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Repeat Rows 1 & 2 until desired length.

Knit 8 rows. Bind off loosely. Wet block to finished measurements.

Macramé Fringe: cut 5 lengths 24" for each fringe spacing fringe approx. 1" apart. (Approx. 15 sets fringe per side or 30 total). Fold in half and attach to short ends of scarf using 5 strands per fringe. Alternate 3 rows of knots across all fringes by dividing each fringe in half and placing in overhand knot with its adjacent half to create trellis effect. See photo.
