

TUHU COWL

Design 8



MATERIALS

One 50g hank each of Tuhu in yarn A and yarn B.
(photographed in yarn A shade Cranberry 2012 and yarn B shade Mole 2014)
One 4mm (US 6) short circular knitting needle.

TENSION

26 stitches and 34 rows to 10cm/4ins square over patten use, using 4mm (US 6) needle.

MEASUREMENTS

45.5cm/17¾ins x 16cm/6¼ins.

ABBREVIATIONS

k	knit.
p	purl.
s2	slip two stitches.
ybk	yarn back between the needles.
[square brackets]	Work all directions inside [square brackets] the number of times stated.

TO MAKE

With 4mm (US 6) needle and yarn A, cast on 119 stitches.
Work in the round as follows, taking care not to twist the stitches when first joining the round:
Purl one round.
1st and 2nd round: with yarn A, knit to end.
3rd and 4th round: with yarn B, [k5, s2]to end.
5th round: with yarn A, [s2, k1, s2, k2]to end.
6th round: with yarn A, [s2, p1, ybk, s2, k2]to end.
7th and 8th round: as 3rd and 4th round.
These 8 rounds form the pattern.
Repeat the last 8 rounds until work measures 14cm/5½ins or until desired length, ending on a 8th round.
With yarn A only: Knit one round.
Purl one round.
Cast off knitwise.

TO MAKE UP

Sew in ends.
