NEEDLES


- 1 pair 3.00mm needles (US 3)
- 1 pair 3.25mm needles (US 4)
- 1 set 3.00mm short circular needles (US 3)
- 1 pair 3.00mm double pointed needles (US 3)

TENSION/GAUGE

25 sts and 32 rows measured over 10 cm of patt using 3.25mm needles.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sk2po - sl 1, k2tog, pass slipped st over.



Lace Pattern 1 (Multi 18 + 1)

Row 1 (RS) P1 * k4, k3tog, yo, k1, yo, k1, yo, sk2po, k4, p1: rep from * to end.

Row 2 (and all WS rows) * K1, p8; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 3 P1 * k2, k3tog, (k1, yo) twice, k1, p1, k1, (yo, k1) twice, sk2po, k2, p1: rep from * to end.

Row 5 P1 * k3tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, k1, k2, sk2po, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 6 As row 2.

These 6 rows form patt rep

Lace Pattern 2 (Multi 9 + 3)

Row 1 K3 * yo, k2, sl 1, k1, pss0, k2tog, k2, yo, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 Purl.

Row 3 K2 * yo, k2, sl 1, k1, pss0, k2tog, k2, yo, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 4 Purl.

These 4 rows form patt rep.

Note: Only increase or decrease when there is room to do both to keep the number of sts correct.

BACK

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 129(147,165) sts. Knit 3 rows.

Establishment rows

Row 1 (RS) K1 (edge st), work row 1 of Lace Pattern 1 in repeat to last st, k1 (edge st).

Row 2 P1 (edge st), work row 2 of Lace Pattern 1 in repeat to last st, p1 (edge st).

These 2 rows set pattern.

Cont working in pattern as set until 7 repeats (42 patt rows) have been completed, dec 6 sts on last row worked. [123(141,159) sts]

Next row (RS) K1 * p1, k1; rep from * to end. (WS) P1 * k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep these 2 rows twice more.

Next row (RS)(make eyelets) Rib 4(3,4) sts, * yo, k2tog, rib 5; rep from * to end.

Work 5 more rows in k1, p1 rib, dec 1 st on last row worked. [122(140,158) sts]

Establishment rows

Row 1 (RS) K1 (edge st), work row 1 of Lace Pattern 2 in repeat to last st, k1 (edge st).

Row 2 P1 (edge st), work row 2 of Lace Pattern 2 in repeat to last st, p1 (edge st).

These 2 rows set pattern.

Cont working in pattern as set until length measures 34 cm from beg, ending on a WS row.

Shape armhole (RS) Cast off 8 sts beg next 2 rows. [106(124,142) sts]

Next row (RS)(dec) Dec 1 st each end next row, then 1 st each end foll alt rows, 9 times more. [86(104,122) sts] **

Cont working straight until length measures 53(54,55) cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulders (RS) Cast off 9(11,12) sts beg next 6 rows.

Leave rem 32(38,50) sts on a holder.

FRONT

Work as for Back to **.

Cont working in pattern as set until length measures 43(44,44) cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape front neck (RS) Patt 35(41,44) sts, turn, leave rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separate.

(WS) Cast off 2 sts beg (neck edge) next row, then beg foll alt row once. [31(37,40) sts]

Patt 1 row.

(WS) Dec 1 st beg next row, then beg foll alt rows 3 times more. [27(33,36) sts]

Cont working straight until length measures same as back to sh sh, ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulders (RS) Cast off 9(11,12) sts beg next row, then beg foll alt rows twice more.

With RS facing, leave 16(22,34) centre sts on a holder, patt to end.

Patt 1 row.

(RS) Cast off 2 sts beg (neck edge) next row, then beg foll alt row once. [31(37,40) sts]

Patt 1 row.

(RS) Dec 1 st beg next row, then beg foll alt rows 3 times more. [27(33,36) sts]

Cont working straight until length measures same as back to sh sh, ending on a RS row.

Shape shoulders (WS) Cast off 9(11,12) sts beg next row, then beg foll alt rows twice more.

SLEEVES

Using 3.00mm needles, cast on 63(67,71) sts.

Row 1 (RS) K1 * p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) P1 * k1, p1; rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work 6 cm in rib, ending on a WS row, inc 3(8,4) sts on last row worked. [66(75,75) sts]

Change to 3.25mm needles.

Cont working in Lace Pattern 2, AT THE SAME TIME **shape sides** as foll (working inc's into pattern): Inc 1 st each end foll 7th row once, then 1 st each end foll 8th rows 10 times, then 1 st each end every 10th row 5 times. [98(107,107) sts]

Cont working straight until length (incl rib) measures 46(48,48) cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape sleeve cap (RS) Cast off 8 sts beg next 2 rows. [82(91,91) sts]

Next row (RS)(dec) Dec 1 st each end next row, then 1 st each end foll alt rows 10 times more.

[60(69,69) sts]

Cast off 2 sts beg every row 4 times. [52(61,61) sts]

Cast off 4 sts beg every row 8(10,10) times.

[20(21,21) sts, 35(37,37) shaping rows]

Cast off rem sts.

MAKING UP

Press pieces gently on WS using a warm iron over a damp cloth. Sew shoulder seams. Sew sleeve seams. Sew side seams. Centre sleeves and sew into place.

Neckband With RS facing, using 3.00mm circular needle, beg at left shoulder seam pickup and k32(35,36) sts along left front, 16(21,34) sts from holder, 31(35,35) sts along right front and 33(39,51) sts. [112(130,156) sts]

Rnd 1 * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep this rnd 4 times more.

Cast off in rib.

I-cord Using 3.00mm double pointed needles, cast on 3 sts. K3, do not turn work, slide sts to right end of needle and pull yarn to tighten. Rep this until length measures 150 cm or desired length. Cast off.
