Queensland Collection LLAMA LACE Col. No. Quantity x 100g hanks
1 5

NEEDLES

1 pair 3.00mm needles (US 3)1 pair 3.25mm needles (US 4)1 set 3.00mm circular needles (US 3)1 cable needle

TENSION/GAUGE

29 sts and 37 rows measured over 10 cm of St st using 3.25mm needles.

MEASUREMENTS

Width approx 66 cm Length approx 150 cm

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

MB (make bobble) (k1, yo, k1, yo, k1) all into next st, turn, p5, turn, sl 1, k1, psso, k3tog, pass 1st st over the k3tog st. (bobble complete) C6B or C6F (Cable 6 Back or Front) slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at back (or front) of work, knit next 3 sts then knit 3 sts from cable needle.

LT (Left Twist) skip 1 st and k 2nd st in back loop, k skipped st in front loop and slip both sts off tog.

RT (Right Twist) skip 1 st and k 2nd st, then k skipped st and slip both sts off tog.

Cable Panel (25 sts)

Row 1 (WS) K4, p17, k4.

Row 2 K4, C6B, k5, C6F, k4.

Row 3 K4, p17, k4.

Row 4 K10, p5, k10.

Row 5 K4, p6, k5, p6, k4.

Row 6 K25.

These 6 rows form patt rep.

Club Pattern (15 sts)

Row 1 (WS) K4, (p1,k1) 4 times, k3.

Row 2 P3, (RT) twice, p1, (LT) twice, p3.

Row 3 K3, (p1,k1) twice, k2, (p1,k1) twice, k2.

Row 4 P2, (RT) twice, p3, (LT) twice, p2.

Row 5 K2, (p1,k1) twice, k4, (p1,k1) twice, k1.

Row 6 P1, (RT) twice, p5, (LT) twice, p1.

Row 7 (k1,p1) twice, k7, (p1,k1) twice.

Row 8 P1, MB, p1, LT, p5, RT, p1, MB, p1.

Row 9 K4, p1, k5, p1, k4.

Row 10 P4, LT, p3, RT, p4.

Row 11 K5, p1, k3, p1, k5.

Row 12 P5, MB, p3, MB, p5.

These 12 rows form patt rep.

WRAP

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 155 sts.

Establishment rows

Row 1 (WS) K25, * work row 1 of Cable Panel, work row 1 of Club Patt Panel; rep from * once more, work row 1 of Cable Panel, k25.

Row 2 (RS) P25, * work row 2 of Cable Panel, work row 2 of Club Patt Panel; rep from * once more, work row 2 of Cable Panel, p25.

These 2 rows set pattern.

Cont working in pattern repeat until length measures approx 150 cm, ending on a WS row. Cast off.

EDGING

Using 3.00mm circular needles, cast on 2 sts.

Row 1 K2.

Row 2 Yf (to make a stitch), k2.

Row 3 Yf, k3.

Row 4 Yf, k4.

Row 5 Yf, k5.

Row 6 Yf, k6.

Row 7 Yf, k7.

Row 8 Yf, k8.

Row 9 Yf, k9.

Row 10 Yf, k10.

Row 11 Yf, k11.

Row 12 Yf, k12.

Break yarn and leave on needle. On same needle, cast on 2 sts and work 2nd point. Cont this way until 13 points have been made, do not break yarn on final point.

Knit across sts of all 13 points (169 sts).

Knit 7 rows more. Cast off.

Sew to cast on edge of wrap.

Repeat at other end.

Sides Work points as for ends, making approx 44 for each side, or sufficient to fit along side edge of wrap.

Sew edging to either side of wrap.

Darn in any loose ends.

Picot Chain Using 3.00mm needles, cast on 5 sts.

* Cast off 4 sts, slip rem st on right-hand needle, cast on 4 sts; rep from * until chain fits along top of points around all 4 sides.
