


tristan eyelet lace shawl

Finished Measurements approximately 22 in x 48 in after blocking

Materials

3 skeins (300g) of Knitting Fever's *Tristan* shade #7 2 needles size US 5/3.75 mm

Gauge 4.5 sts= 1 inch

The legend of Tristan and Isolde takes place during the Middle Ages, when knighthood and the chivalric code prevailed. The tragic story is of the adulterous love between the Cornish knight Tristan and the Irish princess Isolde. Since it first appeared in the 12th century, this popular tale has had a substantial impact on Western art and literature to include the romance of Lancelot and Guinevere in King Arthur and the Knights of the Round Table in the land of Camelot. Here, the tragic beauty of these tales is depicted in Knitting Fever's new yarns, Tristan and Isolde.

Instructions

Cast on 7 sts Row 1: k2, y0, k1, y0, pm, k1, pm, y0, k1, y0, k2 Row 2: k2, purl to last 2 sts, k2 (11 sts)

Stockinette Section

Row 3: k2, yo, k to marker, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2 Row 4: k2, purl to last 2 sts, k2 Repeat Rows 3 & 4, ten times (55 sts)

Eyelet Section

Row 5: K2, yo, k1, *yo, k2tog, repeat from * to marker, yo, sm, k1, sm, **yo, k2tog, repeat from ** to last 3 sts, yo, k1, yo, k2. Row 6: k2, purl to last 2 sts, k2

Repeat Rows 3-4 (Stockinette section) ten times, then repeat Rows 5-6 (Eyelet section) once Repeat from *** to *** until desired length.

Repeat Rows 3-4.

Last four rows: knit across.

Bind off loosely. Block to desired measurements.
