


fiber fantasy necklace



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Finished Measurements approx. 22" length including clasp

Materials

2-4 skeins total of various Knitting Fever novelty yarns*

*The more variety of yarns, the better the finished piece will look. Recommended yarns: Dazzle, Dazzle Metallic, Flutter, Flutter Metallic, Dream, Schmaltz, etc. A minimum of 2 types of yarn but as many as 5-6 can be used together.

12 size E/6 glass beads

12" 24mm wire

- 2 crimp beads
- clasp of your choice (can be toggle, magnetic, barrel, lobster, etc.)

Instructions

Cut each yarn that you are using into three or four 50" lengths. To determine the final look of the necklace, you can preview it by folding this length in half and twisting it upon itself. Add more lengths of yarn to increase the fullness of the finished piece.

Holding all the yarns together as one, fold the entire length in half to approx. 25" and knot the ends together.

Finishing

Cut 12" wire in half. Fold both 6" pieces in half. Insert one through the folded loop end and one through the knotted end of necklace. Thread 6 beads onto each folded wire. Finish with crimp bead. Squeeze crimp bead closed with pliers until secure. Attach clasp using pliers.

Wear with panache!
