### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

#### 1x1 Rib.

**1st Row:** \*K1, P1, rep from \* to last st, K1.  
**2nd Row:** P1, \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.  
 Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

#### St-St. Stocking Stitch.

**1st Row:** Knit.  
**2nd Row:** Purl.  
 Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

**M1. Make one stitch.** Pick up loop between last and next stitch and work into back of this loop.

### DIRECTIONS

#### POCKET LININGS (Both alike)

Using **3.25mm (US3) needles** cast on 28sts and work 30 rows in st-st. Leave these sts on a stitch holder.

#### BACK

Using **2.75mm (US2) needles** cast on 107

[121:135:149:163:177]sts and work in 1x1 rib for 5cm, 2in, ending with a ws row.

**Change to 3.25mm (US3) needles** and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Back measures 22cm, 8¾in, ending with a ws row.

Work 18 rows more.

#### Shape Armholes

Cast off 3 [3:3:4:4]sts at beg of next 2 rows.

101 [115:129:141:155:169]sts.

Work 2 [4:6:8:10:14] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

97 [107:117:125:135:141]sts.

Work 4 [6:8:10:16:16] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row.

93 [101:109:115:119:125]sts.

Work 41 [41:45:41:37:41] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row.

71 [79:85:93:99:103]sts.

Cont without shaping until armholes measures 19 [21:23:25:27:29]cm, 7½ [8¼: 9:9¾:10¾:11½]in, ending with a ws row.

#### Shape Neck

**Next Row:** K13 [14:15:17:20:20]sts, turn, leave rem 58 [65:70:76:79:83]sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 13 [14:15:17:20:20]sts only proceed as follows:-

**Next Row:** Purl.

Work 7 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.

6 [7:8:10:13:13]sts.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Cast off.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem 58 [65:70: 76:79:83]sts and proceed as follows:-

**Next Row:** Cast off 45 [51:55:59:59:63]sts, knit to end.

13 [14:15:17:20:20]sts.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Work 7 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.

6 [7:8:10:13:13]sts.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Cast off.

#### LEFT FRONT

Using **2.75mm (US2) needles** cast on 50 [58:64:72:78:86]sts.

### MEASUREMENTS

#### To Fit Bust

This is a tight fitting style, please select your usual size.

#### Full Length (approximately)

### MATERIALS

200 [200:300:300:400:400]g of Araucania Quemchi Shade 7.

1 Pair 3.25mm (US3) knitting needles.

1 Pair 2.75mm (US2) knitting needles.

1 2.75mm (US2) 80cm circular needle.

Stitch holders.

6 Buttons.

### TENSION

28sts and 36 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stocking stitch using **3.25mm (US3) knitting needles** or the size required to give the correct tension.

**Important Notes:** Instructions are given for 71/76cm, 28/30in, larger sizes are given in square brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

**1st Row:** \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

1st row sets rib.

Work in rib for 5cm, 2in, ending with a rs row.

**Next Row:** Rib to end inc 1 st in centre of row for **1st, 3rd and 5th sizes only**.

51 [58:65:72:79:86]sts.

**Change to 3.25mm (US3) needles** and working in st-st (throughout) work 30 rows.

**Place Pocket**

**Next Row:** K11 [18:25:32:39:46]sts, slip 28sts onto a stitch holder, knit across 28sts left on a stitch holder for first pocket lining, K12.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Cont until left front measures 22cm, 8¾in, ending with a ws row.

**Shape Front Edge**

**Next Row:** Knit to last 2sts, K2tog (front edge).

50 [57:64:71:78:85]sts.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Work 16 rows dec 1 st at front edge in next and every foll alt row.

42 [49:56:63:70:77]sts.

**Shape Armhole**

**Next Row:** Cast off 3 [3:3:4:4:4]sts, knit to last 2sts, K2tog.

38 [45:52:58:65:72]sts.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Work 2 [4:6:8:10:14] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at front edge in next and every foll 0 [2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd] row.

35 [39:43:46:50:51]sts.

Work 4 [6:8:10:16:16] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at front edge in next and every foll 2nd [2nd:2nd:2nd:4th:4th] row.

31 [33:35:36:38:39]sts.

Work 41 [41:45:41:37:41] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row.

9 [11:11:14:18:17]sts.

Work 12 [16:12:16:20:16] rows dec 1 st at front edge only in 4th and every foll 4th row.

6 [7:8:10:13:13]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures same as back armhole, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

## RIGHT FRONT

Using **2.75mm (US2) needles** cast on 50 [58:64:72:78:86]sts.

**1st Row:** \*P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

1st row sets rib.

Work in rib for 5cm, 2in, ending with a rs row.

**Next Row:** Rib to end inc 1 st in centre of

row for **1st, 3rd and 5th sizes only**.

51 [58:65:72:79:86]sts.

**Change to 3.25mm (US3) needles** and working in st-st (throughout) work 30 rows.

**Place Pocket**

**Next Row:** K12, slip 28sts onto a stitch holder, knit across 28sts left on a stitch holder for second pocket lining, K11 [18:25:32:39:46].

**Next Row:** Purl.

Cont until right front measures 22cm, 8¾in, ending with a ws row.

**Shape Front Edge**

**Next Row:** K2tog (front edge), knit to end.

50 [57:64:71:78:85]sts.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Work 17 rows dec 1 st at front edge in next and every foll alt row.

41 [48:55:62:69:76]sts.

**Shape Armhole**

**Next Row:** Cast off 3 [3:3:4:4:4]sts, purl to end.

38 [45:52:58:65:72]sts.

Work 2 [4:6:8:10:14] rows dec 1 st at front edge in next and every foll 0 [2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd] row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row.

35 [39:43:46:50:51]sts.

Work 4 [6:8:10:16:16] rows dec 1 st at front edge in next and every foll 2nd [2nd:2nd:2nd:4th:4th] row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row.

31 [33:35:36:38:39]sts.

Work 41 [41:45:41:37:41] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row.

9 [11:11:14:18:17]sts.

Work 12 [16:12:16:20:16] rows dec 1 st at front edge only in 4th and every foll 4th row.

6 [7:8:10:13:13]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures same as back armhole, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

## BORDER

Join shoulder seams. With rs facing, using **2.75mm (US2) circular needle** and commencing at lower edge of right front, pick up and knit 20sts evenly along rib, 54sts evenly along straight edge, 86 [92:98:106:112:118]sts evenly along shaped edge, 9sts evenly along right side of back neck, 45 [51:55:59:59:63]sts from cast off sts at back of neck, 9sts evenly along left side of neck, 86 [92:98:106:112:118]sts evenly along shaped edge, 54sts evenly along straight edge and 20sts evenly along rib.

383 [401:417:437:449:465]sts.

**Next Row:** Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 2 rows.

**Next Row:** Rib 4, cast off 2sts, (rib 10, cast off 2sts) 5 times, rib to end.

**Next Row:** Rib to last 59sts, cast on 2sts, (rib 11, cast on 2sts) 5 times, rib 4.

Work 2 rows more in rib.

Cast off in rib.

## ARMHOLE BORDERS (Both alike)

With rs facing, using **2.75mm (US2)**

**needles** pick up and knit 149 [161:173:185:197:209]sts evenly all round armhole edge.

**Next Row:** Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 6 rows.

Cast off in rib.

## POCKET BORDERS (Both alike)

With rs facing, using **2.75mm (US2)**

**needles** work across 28sts left on a stitch holder as follows:-

**Next Row:** Cast on 1 st, K4, m1, (K5, m1) 4 times, K4, cast on 1 st. 35sts.

(Cast on sts to be used for sewing pocket borders to fronts).

**Next Row:** Knit.

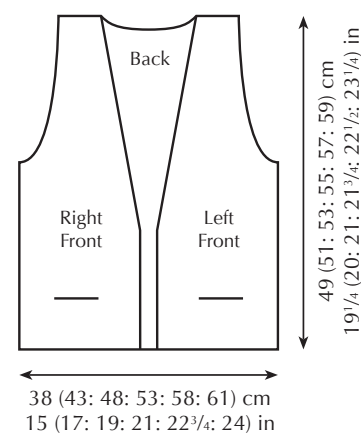
Commencing with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work 6 rows.

Cast off in rib.

## TO COMPLETE

Join side and armhole border seams. Sew pocket linings in position. Sew pocket borders in position using cast on sts. Sew on buttons.
