MEASUREMENTS

To Fit Bust

cm 71/76 81/86 91/97 102/107 112/117 122/127
in 28/30 32/34 36/38 40/42 44/46 48/50

This is a close fitting style. Please select your usual size.

Full Length (approximately)

cm 28 30 32 34 36 38
in 11 11¼ 12½ 13½ 14 15

Sleeve Length

cm 43 46 46 47 48 48
in 17 18 18 18½ 19 19

MATERIALS

200 [200:300:300:400:400]g of Araucania Calbuco Shade 7.

1 Pair of 3.25mm (US3) knitting needles.

1 Pair of 2.75mm (US2) knitting needles.

TENSION

28sts and 36 rows to 10cm, 4in worked to stocking stitch tension using 3.25mm (US3) knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Important Notes: Instructions are given for 71/76cm, 28/30in, larger sizes are given in square brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

1x1 Rib.

1st Row: *K1, P1, rep from * to last st, K1.

2nd Row: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

DIRECTIONS

LEFT FRONT

TIE

Using 3.25mm (US3) needles cast on 5sts and work in 1x1 rib for 26cm, 10¼in, ending with a ws row.

Leave these 5sts on a spare needle.

MAIN PART

Using 3.25mm (US3) needles cast on 52 [60:66:74:80:88]sts and with rs facing, rib across 5sts left on a spare needle.

57 [65:71:79:85:93]sts.

Working in 1x1 rib (throughout) work 4 rows.

Next Row: Rib to last 7sts, rib3tog, rib 4.

55 [63:69:77:83:91]sts.

Next Row: Rib.

Last 2 rows set front shaping.

Work 30 rows dec 2 sts as before in 5th and every foll 6th row.

45 [53:59:67:73:81]sts.

Shape Armhole

Next Row: Cast off 4 [7:7:9:9:9]sts in rib, rib to end.

41 [46:52:58:64:72]sts.

Next Row: Rib.

Work 4 [4:6:8:10:12] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row **AT SAME TIME** dec 2 sts at front edge as before in 3rd and foll 0 [0:0:0:6th:6th] row.

35 [40:44:48:50:56]sts.

Work 3 [7:9:11:13:19] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row

AT SAME TIME dec 2 sts at front edge as before in 0 [5th:3rd:1st:5th:3rd] and every foll 0 [0:6th:6th:6th:6th] row.

33 [34:35:38:39:40]sts.

Work 32 [28:24:26:22:14] rows dec 2 sts at front edge only as before in 2nd [4th:6th:2nd:4th:2nd] and every foll 6th row.

21 [24:27:28:31:34]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 18 [20:22:24:26:28]cm, ending with a ws row.

Cast off in rib.

RIGHT FRONT

TIE

Using 3.25mm (US3) needles cast on 5sts and work in 1x1 rib for 26cm, 10¼in, ending with a ws row.

Do not break off yarn, proceed as follows:-

MAIN PART

Next Row: Rib across 5sts of Tie, using same needle and yarn cast on 52 [60:66:74:80:88]sts. 57 [65:71:79:85:93]sts. Working in 1x1 rib (throughout) work 4 rows.

Next Row: Rib 4, s1, K2tog, pssso, rib to end.

55 [63:69:77:83:91]sts.

Next Row: Rib.

Last 2 rows set front shaping.

Work 31 rows dec 2 sts **as before** in 5th and every foll 6th row.

45 [53:59:67:73:81]sts.

Shape Armhole

Next Row: Cast off 4 [7:7:9:9:9]sts in rib, rib to end.

41 [46:52:58:64:72]sts.

Work 4 [4:6:8:10:12] rows dec 2 sts at front edge **as before** in 3rd and foll 0 [0:0:6th:6th:6th] row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row.

35 [40:44:48:50:56]sts.

Work 3 [7:9:11:13:19] rows dec 2 sts at front edge **as before** in 0 [5th:3rd:1st:5th:3rd] and every foll 0 [0:6th:6th:6th:6th] row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row.

33 [34:35:38:39:40]sts.

Work 32 [28:24:26:22:14] rows dec 2 sts at front edge only **as before** in 2nd [4th:6th:

2nd:4th:2nd] and every foll 6th row.

21 [24:27:28:31:34]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 18 [20:22:24:26:28]cm, 7 [8:8¾:9½:10¼:11]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off in rib.

BACK

Using 3.25mm (US3) needles cast on 107 [123:135:151:163:179]sts and working in 1x1 rib (throughout) work 36 rows.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 [7:7:9:9:9]sts in rib at beg of next 2 rows. 99 [109:121:133:145:161]sts.

Work 4 [4:6:8:10:12] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

91 [101:109:117:125:137]sts.

Work 3 [7:9:11:13:19] rows dec 1 dec at each end of next and every foll alt row.

87 [93:99:105:111:117]sts.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 18 [20:22:24:26:28]cm, 7 [8:8¾:9½:10¼:11]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off in rib.

SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 2.75 (US2) needles cast on 65 [65:67:67:71:71]sts and work 10 rows in 1x1 rib.

Change to 3.25mm (US3) needles and working in 1x1 rib (throughout) work 10 rows more.

Work 111 [127:129:134:121:133] rows inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 10th [9th:8th:7th:6th:6th] row, working increased sts in rib.

89 [95:101:107:113:117]sts.

Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 43 [46:46:47:48:48]cm, 17 [18:18:18½:19:19]in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 4 [7:7:9:9:9]sts in rib at beg of next 2 rows.

81 [81:87:89:95:99]sts.

Work 10 [8:6:4:6:6] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

61 [65:75:81:83:87]sts.

Work 22 [34:44:54:56:60] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row.

39 [31:31:27:27:27]sts.

Work 10 [6:6:4:4:4] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

19sts.


Cast off 5 sts in rib at beg of next 2 rows. 9sts.

Cast off rem 9sts in rib

TO COMPLETE

Join shoulder seams. Fold Sleeves in half lengthways then placing folds to shoulder seams sew Sleeves in position. Join side and Sleeve seams. Tie at front.
