# **MATERIALS**

300 [300:400:400:500:600]g of Araucania Antihue Shade 5.

- 1 Pair 5mm (US8) knitting needles.
- 1 Pair 4mm (US6) knitting needles.
- 1 Pair 3.25mm (US3) knitting needles. Stitch holders.

## **TENSION**

22sts and 28 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stocking stitch using 4mm (US6) knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

# **A2004 TOP**

Important Notes: Instructions are given for 71/76cm, 28/30in, larger sizes are given in square brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

2x2 Rib.

1st Row: \*K2, P2, rep from \* to last

2sts, K2.

2nd Row: P2, \*K2, P2, rep from \* to

end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stocking Stitch.

1st Row: Knit. 2nd Row: Purl.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

M1. Make one stitch. Pick up loop between last and next stitch and work into the back of this loop.

## **DIRECTIONS**

### **FRONT**

Using 4mm (US6) needles cast on 145 [169:193:213:237:257]sts and knit 4

Change to 5mm (US8) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until front measures 13cm, 51/4in, ending with a rs row.

Next Row: K1, (K2tog) 72 [84:96:106:

118:128] times.

73 [85:97:107:119:129]sts.

Change to 4mm (US6) needles and commencing with 2nd row of st-st work 2 rows more.

Shape Sides

1st Row: K2, m1, knit to last 2sts, m1,

K2. 75 [87:99:109:121:131]sts.

2nd Row: Purl.

1st and 2nd rows set side shapings. Work 55 rows inc 1 st at each end as before in 7th and every foll 8th row. 89 [101:113:123:135:145]sts. Cont without shaping until front measures 37cm, 14½in, ending with a

ws row.

### Shape Armholes

Cast off 5 [5:5:6:6:6]sts at beg of next 2 rows.

79 [91:103:111:123:133]sts. Work 2 [2:6:6:8:10] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

75 [87:91:99:107:113]sts.

Work 3 [7:7:9:11:13] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 71 [79:83:89:95:99]sts.\*\*

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 4 [6:8:10:12:14]cm, 1½ [2½: 3:4:4¾:5½]in, ending with a ws row.

### Shape Neck

Next Row: K20 [24:25:28:30:32]sts, turn, leave rem 51 [55:58:61:65:67]sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 20 [24:25:28:30:32] sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row: Purl.

Work 7 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.

13 [17:18:21:23:25]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 17 [19:21:23:25:27]cm,  $6\frac{1}{2}$  [ $7\frac{1}{2}$ : $8\frac{1}{4}$ : $9\frac{3}{4}$ : $10\frac{3}{4}$ ]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

With rs facing, working on rem 51 [55: 58:61:65:67]sts, slip first 31 [31:33:33: 35:35]sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 20 [24:25:28:30:32]sts and knit to end.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 7 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 13 [17:18:21:23:25]sts. Cont without shaping until armhole

measures 17 [19:21:23:25:27]cm,  $6\frac{1}{2}$  [7½:8½:9:9¾:10¾]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

#### **BACK**

Work as given for Front until \*\* is reached.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 17 [19:21:23:25:27]cm,  $6\frac{1}{2}$  [ $7\frac{1}{2}$ : $8\frac{1}{4}$ : $9:9\frac{3}{4}$ : $10\frac{3}{4}$ ]in, ending with a ws row.

Next Row: Cast off 13 [17:18:21:23: 25]sts, K44 [44:46:46:48:48], cast off rem 13 [17:18:21:23:25]sts. Leave centre 45 [45:47:47:49:49]sts on a stitch holder.

### SLEEVES (Both alike)

**Using 4mm (US6) needles** cast on 70 [78:82:94:102:106]sts.

Working in 2x2 rib (throughout) work 6 [6:6:8:8:8] rows.

#### Shape Sleeve Top

Work 6 [6:10:14:16:18] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

58 [66:62:66:70:70]sts.

Work 10 [10:10:10:14:10] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row.

48 [56:52:56:56:60]sts.

Work 12 [16:14:16:16:18] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

24sts.

Cast off 4sts in rib at beg of next 2 rows.

16sts.

Cast off rem 16sts in rib.

#### Neckband

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, using 3.25mm (US3) needles pick up and knit 35sts evenly along left side of neck, 31 [31:33:33:35:35]sts left on a stitch holder at front of neck, 35sts evenly along right side of neck and 45 [45:47:47:49:49]sts left on a stitch holder at back of neck. 146 [146:150:150:154:154]sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 2x2 rib work 8 rows.


Cast off in rib.

#### TO COMPLETE


Join left shoulder and Neckband seams. Sew sleeves in position sewing first 6 [6:6:8:8:8]rows to cast off sts at armholes of back and front.

Join side seams.
