NEEDLES

- 1 pair 4.00mm needles (US 6)
- 1 pair 4.50mm needles (US 7)

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1 button

TENSION/GAUGE

17 sts and 30 rows measured over 10cm (approx 4 in) of pattern using 4.50mm needles.

Pattern Repeat

Row 1 (RS) K1 * yf, sl 1 k/wise, k1, pssso; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 As row 1. These 2 rows form patt rep.

BACK

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 110(120,130) sts. Work 8 cm in Garter st (k all rows, first row worked is WS), dec 16(18,18) sts evenly on last row worked. [94(102,112) sts]

Change to 4.50mm needles.

Cont working in pattern repeat until length (incl band) measures 28 cm, ending on a WS row.

Beg inc for sleeve (RS) Keeping patt correct, inc 1 st each end next row, then 1 st each end foll alt row 4 times, then 1 st each end foll rows 5 times more. [114(122,132) sts]

Cont working straight until length (incl band) measures 52(53,54) cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulder (RS) Cast off 12(13,14) sts, patt 35(37,40) sts, turn, leave rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately.

(WS) Cast off 5 sts, patt to end.

(RS) Cast off 12(13,14) sts, patt to end.

(WS) Patt 1 row.

(RS) Cast off rem 13(14,16) sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off 10(12,14) centre sts, patt to end.

(WS) Cast off 12(13,14) sts, patt to end.

(RS) Cast off 5 sts, patt to end.

(WS) Cast off 12(13,14) sts, patt to end.

(RS) Patt 1 row.

(WS) Cast off rem 13(14,16) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 55(60,65) sts. Work 8 cm in Garter st as for back, ending on a WS row dec 7(8,9) sts evenly on last row worked. [48(52,56) sts]

Change to 4.50mm needles.

Cont working in pattern repeat until length (incl band) measures 28 cm **, ending on a WS row.

Beg inc for sleeve (RS) Keeping patt correct, inc 1 st beg (armhole edge) next row, then 1 st beg foll alt rows 4 times, then 1 st at armhole edge every foll row 5 times more. [58(62,66) sts]

Cont working straight until length (incl band) measures 42(43,44) cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape front neck (RS) Cast off 7(8,8) sts beg (neck edge) next row, patt to end. [51(54,58) sts]

(WS) Patt to last 2 sts, k2tog.

(RS) K2tog, patt to end.

Rep last 2 rows 6 times more. [37(40,44) sts, 15 shaping rows]

Cont working straight until length measures same as back to sh sh, ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulder (RS) Cast off 12(13,14) sts beg next row, then beg foll alt row once.

Patt 1 row.

Cast off rem 13(14,16) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for left front to **, ending on a RS row.

Beg inc for sleeve (WS) Keeping patt correct, inc 1 st beg (armhole edge) next row, then 1 st beg foll alt rows 4 times, then 1 st at armhole edge every foll row 5 times more.

[58(62,66) sts]

Cont working straight until length (incl band) measures 42(43,44) cm, ending on a RS row.

Shape front neck (WS) Cast off 7(8,8) sts beg (neck edge) next row, patt to end.

[51(54,58) sts]

(RS) Patt to last 2 sts, k2tog.

(WS) K2tog, patt to end.

Rep last 2 rows 6 times more. [37(40,44) sts, 15 shaping rows]

Cont working straight until length measures same as back to sh sh, ending on a RS row.

Shape shoulder (WS) Cast off 12(13,14) sts beg next row, then beg foll alt row once.

Patt 1 row.

Cast off rem 13(14,16) sts.

MAKING UP

Using a warm iron over a damp cloth, press pieces gently.

With RS tog, sew shoulder seams.

Armbands With RS facing, using 4.00mm needles, pickup and knit 66(70,74) sts along straight edge of armhole.

Cont working in Garter st until length measures 4 cm, ending on a WS row.

Cast off.

Repeat for other side.

Neckband With RS facing, using 4.00mm needles, pickup and knit 35(37(39) sts along right side front neck, 46(48,50) sts across back neck and 35(37,39) sts along left side front neck.

[116(122,128) sts]

Cont working in Garter st until length measures 6 cm, ending on a WS row.

Cast off.

Front bands Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 9 sts.

Left front Cont working in Garter st until length fits along left front from cast on edge to cast off edge of neck band, ending on a WS row.

Cast off. Sew band into place. Place a marker approx 4 cm below cast off edge.

Right front Work as for left front to marker, ending on a WS row.

Buttonhole row (RS) K4, yf k2tog, k to end.

Cont working in Garter st until length measures same as left front band, ending on a WS row.

Cast off.

Sew band into place.

Sew button to left band.
