MEASUREMENTS

Circumference approx 100 cm (39½ in) **Length** 40 cm (15¾ in)

Col. No. Quantity x 100g balls 04 2

NEEDLES

1 set 6.50mm circular needles (US 10.5) 1 cable needle

TENSION/GAUGE

19 sts and 18 rows measured over 10 cm (approx 4 in) of Pattern using 6.50mm needles.

Special Abbreviations

C6 (Cross 6) slip next 4 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, knit next 2 sts from left-hand needle, slip 2 purl sts from cable needle back to left-hand needle. Pass cable needle with rem knit sts to back of work, purl 2 sts from left-hand needle, then knit the 2 sts from cable needle.

Cable Pattern

Rnds 1+2 * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3 * [K2 ,p2] twice, C6, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 4-10 (incl) As rnd 1.

These 10 rnds form pattern repeat.

COMI


Using 6.50mm circular needles, cast on 192 sts, pm, taking care not to twist sts.

Cont working in pattern repeat until 4 repeats have been worked, work rnds 1-3 once more. [43 rnds]

Next rnd (dec) * [K3 tog] twice, [p2, k2] twice, p2; rep from * to end. [144 sts]

Cont working in rnds of k2, p2 rib until total length measures 40 cm. Cast off loosely in rib.

Darn in any loose ends.
