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NEEDLES

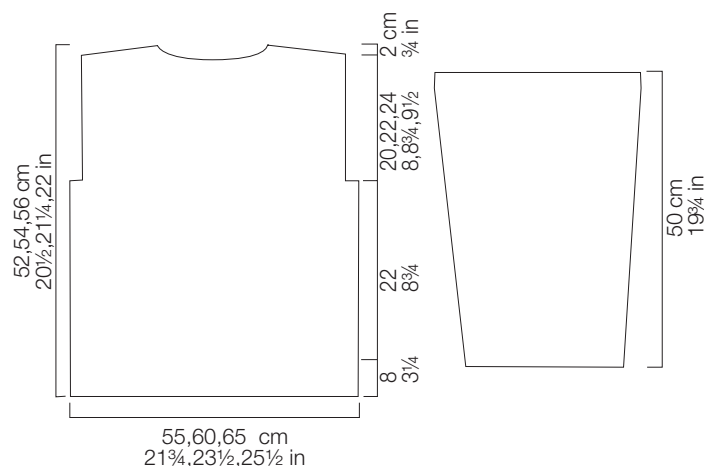
1 pair 6.00mm needles (US 10)

1 pair 6.50mm needles (US 10.5)

TENSION/GAUGE

14 sts and 18 rows measured over 10 cm (approx 4 in) of St st using 6.50mm needles.

22.5 sts and 18 rows measured over 10 cm (approx 4 in) of Rib using 6.50mm needles.



BACK

Using 6.50mm needles, cast on 78(88,98) sts.

Row 1 (RS) * K3, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 2 (WS) * P3, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont working in rib until length measures 8 cm ending on a WS.

Cont working in St st, beg with a k row, until length (incl rib) measures 30 cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape armholes (RS) Cast off 4 sts beg next 2 rows.

[70(80,90) sts] **

Cont working in St st until length (incl rib) measures 50(52,54) cm, ending on a WS row.



Shape shoulders and back neck (RS) K30(33,36) sts, turn, leave rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately.
 (WS) Cast off 5 sts, p to end.
 (RS) Cast off 6(7,8) sts, k to end.
 (WS) Cast off 5 sts, p to end.
 (RS) Cast off 6(7,8) sts, k to end.
 (WS) Purl.
 (RS) Cast off rem 8(9,10) sts.
 With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off 10(14,18) centre sts, k to end.
 (WS) Cast off 6(7,8) sts, p to end.
 (RS) Cast off 5 sts, k to end.
 (WS) Cast off 6(7,8) sts, p to end.
 (RS) Cast off 5 sts, k to end.
 (WS) Cast off rem 8(9,10) sts.

FRONT

Work as for Back to **.
 Cont working in St st until length (incl rib) measures 45(47,49) cm, ending on a WS row.
Shape front neck (RS) K30(33,36) sts, turn, leave rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately.
 (WS) P2tog, p to end.
 (RS) K to last 2 sts, k2tog.
 Rep last 2 rows, 3 times more.
Shape shoulders and front neck (WS) P2tog, p to end.
 (RS) Cast off 6(7,8) sts, k to last 2 sts, k2tog.
 P 1 row.
 (RS) Cast off rem 8(9,10) sts.
 With RS facing, leave 10(14,18) centre sts on holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts, k2tog, k to end.
 (WS) P to last 2 sts, p2tog.
 (RS) K2tog, k to end.
 Rep last 2 rows 3 times more.
 (WS) Cast off 6(7,8) sts, p to last 2 sts, p2tog.
 K 1 row.
 (WS) Cast off 6(7,8) sts, p to end.
 K 1 row.
 (WS) Cast off rem 8(9,10) sts.

SLEEVES

Using 6.00mm needles, cast on 50(55,60) sts.
 (RS) * K3, p2; rep from * to end.
 (WS) * K2, p3; rep from * to end.
 These 2 rows form rib.
 Cont working in rib until length measures 5 cm, ending on a WS row.
 Change to 6.50mm needles.
 Cont keeping rib correct, working inc's into patt, AT THE SAME TIME **shape sides** as foll: Inc 1 st each end next row, then 1 st each end foll 5th rows 5 times, then 1 st each end foll 5th rows 9 times more. [80(85,90) sts, 71 shaping rows]
 Cont working straight until length measures 50 cm from beg, ending on a WS row.
 Cast off.

MAKING UP

Press pieces gently using a warm iron over a damp cloth.
 Sew right shoulder seam.

Collar

With RS facing, using 6.00mm needles, pickup and k15 sts along left side front neck, 10(14,18) sts from holder, 15 sts along right side front neck, 35(36,37) sts across back neck. [75(80,85) sts]
Row 1 (WS) * K3, p2; rep from * to end.
Row 2 (RS) * K2, p3; rep from * to end.
 These 2 rows form rib.
 Cont working in rib until length measures 20 cm, ending on a WS row.
 Cast off in rib.
 Sew left shoulder and collar seam.
 Centre sleeves and sew into armhole.
 Sew sleeve and side seams.
