ABBREVIATIONS & KEY

CO cast on Knit or K or P Purl or k2tog Knit 2 stitches together through front loop or ssk Slip 1 st knit-wise, slip next st knit-wise: knit those two slipped stitches together No Stitch (to make chart easier to read) or c2pR Slip 1 to cable needle, hold to back, knit 2, work st from cable needle. or c2pL Slip 2 knits to cable needle, hold to front, work one from needle, knit 2 from cable needle. or c1L Slip 1 st to cable needle, hold to front, work 1 from needle, work one from cable needle. or c1R Slip 1 st to cable needle, hold to back, work 1 from needle, work one from cable needle. or c1-2L Slip 1 st to cable needle, hold to front, work 2 from needle, work one from cable needle. or c1-2R Slip 1 st to cable needle, hold to back, work 2 from needle work one from cable needle

MATERIALS

Yarn:	Louisa Harding's <i>Mila</i> 100 grams.
Gauge:	Approx. 16sts per 4in/10cm in stockinette stitch on size US 8.
Needles:	US 7/4.5mm 16in circular
	US 8/5mm 16in circular needle and DPNS (or size needed to obtain gauge)

RIBBING

With US 7/4.5mm CO 80 sts, PM Rib Rounds 1-10: (k2, p2) repeat around.

BODY

Switch to US 8/5mm Round 1: (k1, m1, k1, p2) repeat around (shift marker one stitch to the right, btw last 2purls)

Round 2: (p1, k3, p1) repeat around Work Cable Chart once.

CABLE CHART

When working all cables, knit the knits and purl the purls. Chart indicates all crossovers, but pay special attention to whether you cross over a knit or a purl and work them as they present themselves.

PLEASE NOTE: not all rows are represented in the chart. Every row omitted should be knit as stitches present themselves; knit all knits, purl all purls.

CABLE NEEDLE IS NOT NECESSARY. Cables may be worked by rearranging stitches on left needle and then knitting, or by pinching stitches to front or back, or any method that works for you!

TOP KNOT (OPTIONAL)


k2tog (5 times)Work 1.5" i-cordk2tog, k2tog, k1, pass last st over k, pass first st over kThread darning needle and pull yarn through last st to secure.Tie i-cord into overhand knot and bring end into the inside of hat, weave tail into top inside of hat to secure knot.Weave in all tails securely.
