

JAVE PONCHO



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Materials

300g of Jade yarn by Knitting Fever (shade #2 shown)

US 10.5 16" circular needle (or size needed to obtain gauge)

US 13 24"circular needle (or size needed to obtain gauge)

Gauge

Approx. 12 sts per 4 in/10 cm in pattern.

Instructions

Note: This piece is worked in the round with wrong side out. When complete, invert garment to see right (public) side.

COLLAR

Cast on 100 sts place marker and join as you begin first round.

Rounds 1-34: K2, P2 around

INCREASE

Switch to US 13 needle

Round 35-35: Knit every stitch

Round 37: *K, kfb* repeat (150sts) **Round 38:** (Kfb,k74) twice (152 sts)

BODY

Round 39: Knit

Round 40: (K1, p1, k1) all in the same stitch, p3tog

Round 41: Knit

Round 42: P3tog, (k1, p1, k1) all in the same stitch Repeat rounds 39-42 for approximately 16 inches

Knit 4 rounds Purl 4 rounds Knit 4 rounds Bind-off loosely.

Turn poncho inside out. Block to open up pattern stitches if desired.

Abbreviations

K Knit

P Purl

St Stitch

PM Place Marker SM Slip Marker

p3tog Purl 3 stitches together through front loop

Kfb Knit into front of stitch and then back of stitch
