Painted Fur Keyhole Scarf



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Instructions

Cast on 3 sts.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: Kfb, k to end of row. (4 sts)

Row 4: K1, P2, K1

Row 5: Kfb, K to end of row (5 sts)

Row 6: K1, P4, K1

Row 7 and all odd rows: Kfb, K to end of row, K1

Row 8 and all even rows: K1, P to last st, K1

Repeat rows 7 & 8 until 20 sts or approx. 7in ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): K10. Turn.

Next row (WS): K1, P7, K2.

Rep last 2 rows until opening measures approx. 1 1/2in ending after knitting RS row. Break yarn. With RS of work still facing, rejoin yarn to rem 10 sts and proceed as follows:

Next row: Knit.

Next row: K2, P7, K1.

Rep last 2 rows until opening measures approx. 1 1/2in ending with WS facing for next row.

Joining row: (K2, P8) across first side of scarf, (P8, K2) across second side of scarf.

Continue working even in st st and keeping 2 sts at each side in garter st until work measures approx. 23in from beginning ending with WS facing for next row.

Next row: k2tog, knit to end of row

Next row: K2, purl to last 2 sts, K2.

Rep last 2 rows until 3 sts remain.

Knit 1 row. Bind off all sts. Weave in ends. †

Measurements

approx. 5in width x 34in length

Materials

- 1 skein (100g) of KFI Luxury Collection's *Painted Fur*
- Size US 10.5 knitting needles

Gauge

Irrelevant for this project

Abbreviations

- K** knit
P purl
RS right side
WS wrong side
Rep repeat
st(s) stitch(es)
St st stockinette stitch
Kfb knit into front and back of stitch to increase by one stitch
