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## BEANIE

### YARN

Ella Rae LACE MERINO

Col. No. Quantity x 100g Hanks  
156 1

### MEASUREMENTS

To fit average sized adult head

Circumference approx 50 cm (19¾ in)

### NEEDLES

1 pair 3.00mm needles (US 3)

1 pair 3.25mm needles (US 4)

### TENSION/GAUGE

44 sts and 38 rows measured over 10 cm

(approx 4 in) of Pattern using 3.25mm needles.

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**Cluster 2** sl 2 wyib, bring yarn to front between needles, sl the same 2 sts back to left-hand needle, pass yarn to back between needles, sl the same 2 sts wyib again. (cluster complete)

#### Star Cluster Pattern

**Row 1 (RS)** K1 \* k2tog, (yo) twice, k2tog-b; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 2** P2 \* p1 (the first yo), p1-b (the second yo); cluster 2; rep from \* to end, p1, p1-b, p2.

**Row 3** K3 \* k2tog, (yo) twice, k2tog-b; rep from \* to end, k3.

**Row 4** P2 \* cluster 2, p1, p1-b; rep from \* to end, cluster 2, p2.

These 4 rows form pattern repeat.

### BEANIE

Using 3.00mm needles, cast on 144 sts.

**Row 1** \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2** As row 1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont working in rib until length measures 4 cm, ending on a RS row.

**Next row (WS)(inc)** \* [K1,yon,p1,yon] twice, [k1,p1] twice; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k1, yon, p1, yon, k1, p1. [218 sts]

Change to 3.25mm needles.

Cont working in patt rep until length (incl rib)

measures approx 20 cm, ending on a Row 4 of pattern.

**Next row (RS)(dec)** K1 \* k2tog; rep from \* to last st, k1. [110 sts]

**Next row (WS)(dec)** \* P2tog; rep from \* to end. [55 sts]

**Next row (RS)(dec)** \* K2tog; rep from \* to last st, k1. [28 sts]

**Next row (WS)(dec)** \* P2tog; rep from \* to end. [14 sts]

Break yarn and thread through rem sts, pull to tighten, fasten off.

Sew seam.

## MITTS

### YARN

Ella Rae LACE MERINO

Col. No. Quantity x 100g Hanks  
156 1

### MEASUREMENTS

One size to fit average adult hand

### NEEDLES

1 pair 2.75mm needles (US 2)

1 pair 3.25mm needles (US 4)

### TENSION/GAUGE

29 sts and 38 rows measured over 10 cm

(approx 4 in) of St st using 3.25mm needles.

### RIGHT MITT

Using 2.75mm needles, cast on 52 sts.

Work 4 rows in St st, beg with a k row.

Change to 3.25mm needles.

**Row 1** \* K2, p2; rep from \* to end.

This row forms rib.

Cont working in rib until length measures 15 cm from beg, ending on a WS row. \*\*

Now cont working in St st.

**Row 1 (RS)(inc)** K26, 'm1', k2, 'm1', k24.

**Row 2+4** K1, p to last st, k1.

**Row 3** Knit.

**Row 5** K26, 'm1', k4, 'm1', k24.

Rep rows 2-4 incl once more.

**Row 9** K26, 'm1', k6, 'm1', k24.

Cont to inc this way (working 2 more sts between inc each time) in foll 4th rows until there are 62 sts on needle.

Work 3 rows in St st.

#### Thumb

**Next row** K41, turn.

**Next row** K1, p14, turn, cast on 3 sts.

Work 6 rows on these 18 sts.

Cast off loosely.

With RS facing, join yarn, k3 sts from cast on sts at base of thumb, k to end. (50sts)

Work 13 rows in St st. \*\*\*

**Next row (RS)** K1 \* p2, k2; rep from \* to last st, k1.

(WS) P1 \* k2, p2; rep from \* to last st, p1.

Rep these 2 rows 4 times more.

Cast off in rib.

### LEFT MITT

Work as for Right Mitt to \*\*.

**Row 1 (RS)(inc)** K24, 'm1', k2, 'm1', k26.

**Row 2+4** K1, p to last st, k1.

**Row 3** Knit.

**Row 5** K24, 'm1', k4, 'm1', k26.

Rep rows 2-4 incl once more.

**Row 9** K24, 'm1', k6, 'm1', k26.

Cont to inc this way (working 2 more sts between inc each time) in foll 4th rows until there are 62 sts on needle.

Work 3 rows in St st.

#### Thumb

**Next row** K36, turn, cast on 3 sts.

**Next row** K1, p16, k1, turn.

Work 6 rows on these 18 sts.

Cast off loosely.

With RS facing, join yarn, k3 sts from cast on sts at base of thumb, k to end. (50 sts)

Work 13 rows in St st.

Work as for Right Mitt from \*\*\* to end.

### MAKING UP

Using a warm iron over a damp cloth, press lightly. Join thumb and side seams.
