

## SIZE

Italian size 44 = US size 10 (approx. Medium).

## MATERIALS

- 650 g balls of Lana Gatto Class shade \#5226 Beaver.
- One pair size US $6(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Cable needle.
- Sewing needle.


## STITCHES

## USING KNITTING NEEDLES:

## Stockinette stitch

## Reverse Stockinette stitch

## 3x3 Rib

Row 1: * k3, p3; rep from * to end.
Row 2: $k$ the knit sts and $p$ the purl sts.
Rep Row 2 for k3, p3 rib.

## Single Cable (work on 6 sts)

Row 1 (RS): k 6.
Row 2: p 6.
Row 3: 6 left crossed sts (slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work, k 3 sts, k 3 sts from cable needle).
Row 4: p 6.
Rep 1- 4 rows.
Double Cable (work on 12 sts)
Row 1 (RS): k 12.
Row 2: p 12.
Row 3: 6 right crossed sts (slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to back of work, k 3 sts, k 3 sts from cable needle), 6 left crossed sts (slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work, k 3 sts, k 3 sts from cable needle).
Row 4: p 12.
Rep 1- 4 rows.

## GAUGE

18 sts and 23 rows to $4 i n / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ over Rib and Cable using size US $6(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ needles.

22 sts and 22 rows to $4 \mathrm{in} / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ over $3 \times 3$ Rib using size US 6 $(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ needles.

## BACK

Work in one piece, starting from a sleeve.
Using size US 6 ( 4 mm ) needles, cast on 120 sts and works as follows:
6 sts in Stockinette st
6 sts in Reverse Stockinette st
6 sts Single Cable
6 sts in Reverse Stockinette st
6 sts in Stockinette st
6 sts in Reverse Stockinette st
12 sts Double Cable
6 sts in Reverse Stockinette st
12 sts Double Cable
6 sts in Reverse Stockinette st
12 sts Double Cable
6 sts in Reverse Stockinette st
6 sts in Stockinette st
6 sts in Reverse Stockinette st
6 sts Single Cable
6 sts in Reverse Stockinette st
6 sts in Stockinette st
When piece measures $43 / 4 \mathrm{in} / 12 \mathrm{~cm}$ from beg, inc 1 st each side on next row and following alternate row, then cast on 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work these new 7 sts on each side in Reverse Stockinette st. There are 134 sts.

When piece measures $81 / 4 \mathrm{in} / 21 \mathrm{~cm}$ from beg, divide work at half of center Double Cable for neck opening of Front and Back. Join a 2 nd ball of yarn and work both pieces (Front and Back) at the same time with separate balls of yarn, working at neck edge of each piece 6 sts in Stockinette st instead of cable.


## CLASS

PULLOVER

When neck opening measures $9 \mathrm{in} / 23 \mathrm{~cm}$, rejoin work and continue as before, working center 12 sts Double Cable. Work 20 rows as established, then shape sleeve. Bind off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows, dec 1 st each side on next row and following alternate row. 120 sts remain. When piece measures $43 / 4 \mathrm{in} / 12 \mathrm{~cm}$ from last decs, bind off all sts.

## WAISTEDGES

Using size US 6 ( 4 mm ) needles with RS facing, pick up and $k$ 83 sts along straight edge of Front. Work in $3 \times 3$ Rib starting and ending with a selvedge st. When waistedge measures $43 / 4 \mathrm{in} / 12 \mathrm{~cm}$ from beg, bind off all sts. Work another waistedge as previous along straight edge of Back.

## FINISHING

Fold piece in half along neck-opening and shoulder line.
Sew sleeve and side seams
