Col. No. Quantity x 100g skiens

8 Silver/Blue	3	4	4
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NEEDLES

1 pair 5.50mm needles (US 9)

TENSION/GAUGE

16 sts and 20 rows measured over 10 cm of Double Moss St using 5.50mm needles.

Rib Pattern (multi 3+2)

(RS) P2 * yb, sl 1 p/wise, yf, p2; rep from * to end.

(WS) K2 * p1, k2; rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form pattern.

Alternating Lace (multi 6+7)

Rows 1,3,5,7 (RS) * K2, yf, sl 1 k/wise, k2tog, pssso, yf, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (and all alt rows) Purl (incl inc's).

Rows 9,11,13,15 K2tog, yf, k1 * k2, yf, sl 1 k/wise, k2tog, pssso, yf, k1; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, yf, sl 1 k/wise, k1, pssso.

These 16 rows form pattern.

SHRUG

Using 5.50mm needles, cast on 35(41,47) sts.

Cont working in Rib patt until length measures 20 cm, ending on a WS row inc 2 sts on last row worked.

[37(43,49) sts]

Now cont working in Alternating Lace pattern until total length measures 35 cm, ending on a WS row.

Cast off.

Make a second piece the same.

Sew back seam.

With RS facing, pickup and knit 72(84,96) sts across top edge of shrug.

Cont working in Garter st (k all rows) until total length measures 50(54,58) cm, ending on a WS row.

Cast off.

MAKING UP

Press gently, using a warm iron over a damp cloth.

Fold shrug in half lining up cast on and cast off edges.

Armbands

Mark a position 14(15,16) cm from folded edge along front and same along back.

With RS facing, using 5.50mm needles, pickup and knit 48(52,56) sts along edge between markers.

Knit 7 rows.

Cast off.

Repeat for other armband.

Sew side seams and armband seams.
