NEEDLES 1 pair 4.00mm needles (US 6) 1 pair 4.50mm needles (US 7)

TENSION/GAUGE

21 sts and 28 rows measured over 10 cm of St st using 4.50mm needles.

Pattern Repeat

Work 20 rows in St st, beg with a k row.Next row (RS) K1 wrapping yarn around needle; rep from * to end.(WS) Purl, dropping wrapped st.Rep last 2 rows 4 times more.These 30 rows form patt rep.

uluru top

BACK

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 94(100,110,118) sts. Cont working in St st, beg with a k row, until length measures 4 cm, ending on a WS row.

Change to 4.50mm needles.

Cont working in patt rep AT THE SAME TIME shape sides as foll: Dec 1 st each end foll 5th row once, then 1 st each end foll 6th rows twice, then 1 st each end foll 4th rows 5 times more.

[78(84,94,102) sts, 37 shaping rows] Work 9 rows.

Next row (RS)(inc) Inc 1 st each end next row, then 1 st each end foll alt rows 5 times, then 1 st each end foll 5th row once. [92(98,108,116) sts]

Cont working in St st for remainder, work straight until length measures 36 cm from beg, ending on a WS row. **Shape armholes** (RS) Cast off 3 sts beg next 2 rows. [86(92,102,110) sts]

Next row (RS)(dec) Dec 1 st each end next 5 rows, then 1 st each end foll alt rows 5(6,7,8) times more. [66(70,78,84) sts]

Cont working straight until length measures 54(55,56,57) cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape neck and shoulders (RS) Patt 18(19,19,21) sts, turn, leave rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately.

(WS) Cast off 5 sts, p to end.

(RS) Cast off 4(4,4,5) sts, k to end.

(WS) Cast off 5 sts, p to end.

(RS) Cast off rem 4(5,5,6) sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts,

cast off 30(32,40,42) centre sts, k to end.

Purl 1 row.

- (RS) Cast off 5 sts, k to end.
- (WS) Cast off 4(4,4,5) sts, p to end.
- (RS) Cast off 5 sts, k to end.
- (WS) Cast off rem 4(5,5,6) sts.

Work FRONT same way as BACK.

MAKING UP

Press pieces gently on WS, using a warm iron over a damp cloth.

Sew shoulder seams. Sew side seams leaving an opening for the armhole of approx 22(23,24,25) cm.
