MATERIALS

300 [400:500:600:700:800]g of Araucania Malipulli Shade 4. 1 Pair 5mm (US8) knitting needles. 1 Pair 4mm (US6) knitting needles. Stitch holders.

TENSION

18sts and 24 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stocking stitch using 5mm (US8) knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

A2007 SWEATER

Important Notes: Instructions are given for 71/76cm, 28/30in, larger sizes are given in square brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

1x1 Rib. 1st Row: *K1, P1, rep from * to last st, K1. 2nd Row: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end. Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stocking Stitch. 1st Row: Knit. 2nd Row: Purl.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows. M1. Make one stitch. Pick up loop between last and next stitch and work into back of this loop.

DIRECTIONS

FRONT

Using 4mm (US6) needles cast on 72 [82:90:100:108:118]sts and work 6 rows in st-st. Change to 5mm (US8) needles and working in st-st (throughout) proceed as follows:-

Work 2 rows.

Shape Sides 1st Row: K2, m1, knit to last 2sts, m1, K2. 74 [84:92:102:110:120]sts.

2nd Row: Purl. 1st and 2nd rows set side shapings. Work 63 rows inc 1 st at each end of

row as before in 15th and every foll 16th row.

82 [92:100:110:118:128]sts. Cont without shaping until Front measures 31cm, 12in, from top of roll, ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 5 [5:5:6:6]sts at beg of next 2 rows.

72 [82:90:98:106:116]sts. Work 6 [6:8:8:10:12] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

60 [70:74:82:86:92]sts.

Work 2 [5:5:7:7:9] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row.

58 [64:68:74:78:82]sts.**

Work 0 [3:5:9:11:11] rows more without shaping.

Shape Neck

Next Row: K17 [20:21:24:25:27]sts, turn, leave rem 41 [44:47:50:53:55]sts on a stitch holder. Working on these 17 [20:21:24:25:27] sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row: Purl.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.

13 [16:17:20:21:23]sts.

Work 9 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row.

8 [11:12:15:16:18]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 17 [19:21:23:25:27]cm, 61/2 [71/2:81/4:9:93/4:103/4]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

With rs facing, working on rem 41 [44: 47:50:53:55]sts, slip first 24 [24:26:26: 28:28]sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 17 [20:21:24:25:27]sts and knit to end.

17 [20:21:24:25:27]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.

13 [16:17:20:21:23]sts.

Work 9 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row.

8 [11:12:15:16:18]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 17 [19:21:23:25:27]cm, 61/2 [71/2:81/4:9:93/4:103/4]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

BACK

Work as given for Front until ** is reached.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 17 [19:21:23:25:27]cm, 61/2 [71/2:81/4:9:93/4:103/4]in, ending with a ws row.

Next Row: Cast off 8 [11:12:15:16:18] sts, K41 [41:43:43:45:45], cast off rem 8 [11:12:15:16:18]sts. Leave centre 42 [42:44:44:46:46]sts on a stitch holder.

SLEEVES (Both alike)

Important

Increases up Sleeves should be worked as follows:-

Work 1 st, m1, work to last st, m1, work 1.

Using 4mm (US6) needles cast on 38 [40:42:44:46:48]sts and work 6 rows st-st.

Change to 5mm (US8) needles and working in st-st (throughout) work 89

[95:93:96:95:101] rows inc 1 st at each end **as indicated** in 5th and every foll 12th [9th:8th:7th:6th:6th] row. 54 [62:66:72:78:82]sts. Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 42 [46:46:47:48:48]cm, 16¹/₂ [18:18¹/₂:19:19]in, from top of roll,

ending with a ws row.

Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 5 [5:5:6:6]sts at beg of next 2 rows.

44 [52:56:60:66:70]sts.

Work 4 [6:6:6:8:10] rows dec 1 st at

each end of every row. 36 [40:44:48:50:50]sts. Work 14 [10:14:18:20:16] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 22 [30:30:30:30:34]sts. Work 4 [8:8:8:8:10] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 14sts. Cast off 2sts at beg of next 2 rows. 10sts. Cast off rem 10sts.

NECKBAND


Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, **using 4mm (US6) needles** pick up and knit 28sts evenly along left side of neck, 24 [24:26:26:28:28]sts left on a stitch holder at front of neck, 29sts evenly along right side of neck and 42 [42:44:44:46:46]sts left on a stitch holder at back of neck. 123 [123:127:127:131:131]sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 8 rows. Cast off in rib.

TO COMPLETE

Join left shoulder and Neckband seams. Fold Sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds to shoulder seams sew Sleeves in position. Join side and Sleeve seams. See ball band for care instructions.
