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# CAP BASIC



## HAT CAP

**MEASUREMENTS:** Approx. 15 3/4" width x 8 1/4" length (40cm x 21 cm)

### MATERIALS

CAP: 1 ball = 1 hat

**Crochet hook** Size J (US) / (6mm)

### Stitches

**Double Crochet:** (see Basic stitches on the Web)

**Slip Stitch:** (see Basic stitches on the Web)

**Chain St:** (see Basic stitches on the Web)

**Single Crochet:** (see Basic stitches on the Web)

**To increase 1 st:** work 2 dc in the same st

### GAUGE

In Double Crochet:

9 sts and 6 rows = 4x4"

**NOTE:** Hat is worked in rows; begin each row with ch 3, end each row with a slip st in beg ch-3; then turn to begin new row.

Before beginning, **cut** 30 feet (9meters) of yarn for **pompom**, then you can work hat until yarn is almost used up.

### INSTRUCTIONS

Wrap the yarn around your finger two times to make a ring, and work 12 dc into ring.

**Row 1:** \* Inc 1 st, dc, \*; rep from \* to \*: [18 dc]

**Row 2:** \* Inc 1 st, dc, \*; rep from \* to \*: [27 dc]

**Row 3:** \* Inc 1 st, 2 dc, \*; rep from \* to \*: [36 dc]

Continue even in *double crochet* until yarn is almost used up; then work 1 row in *single crochet*. **Fasten off** and weave in all ends

**Pom-pom:** (see Basic stitches on the Web)

Make a 2 3/8" (6cm) diameter pom-pom

**Sew** the pompon to top of hat.

## NECK WARMER CAP

**MEASUREMENTS:** Approx. 10 5/8" (27cm) width

### MATERIALS

CAP: 1 ball = 1 Neck Warmer

**Knitting needles:** Size 13 (U.S)/ (9mm)

### Stitches

**Garter St:** (see Basic stitches on the Web)

**Stockinette St:** (see Basic stitches on the Web)

**Pattern St:** \* work 5 rows *Stockinette St*, on next row (wrong side), knit across, \*; rep from \* to \*

### GAUGE

In *Pattern St*:

9 sts 15 rows = 4x4"

### INSTRUCTIONS

**Cast on** 25 sts.

**Set up** pattern as follows:

2 *Garter Sts*, 21 *Pattern Sts*, 2 *Garter Sts*.

Work in established pattern until the ball is nearly finished; **bind/cast off** very loosely.

Using *Side Seams* (see Basic stitches on the Web), **sew** cast-on and bound-off edges together.

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
