MATERIALS

1 skein of Queensland Collection's *Llama Lace Melange* shade #07 Needles size US 4, 32in circular (or size needed to obtain gauge)

GAUGE

21 sts x 40 rows = 4in before blocking (or $3\frac{1}{2}$ motifs x 10 motifs = 4in)

ABBREVIATIONS

BO Bind Off Sl1 Slip stitch without working

 Slip, Slip, Knit

LITTLE ARROW HEAD LACE

Round 1: YO, SSK, K, K2tog, YO, K-tbl

Round 2: K

Round 3: K, YO, SK2P, YO, K, K-tbl

Round 4: K

THE PATTERN

CO 150 sts. Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist.

Place marker to designate beginning of round

Knit one round

Purl one round

Begin working in Little Arrow Head Lace pattern.

Round 1: *YO, SSK, K, K2tog, YO, K-tbl, repeat from * around

Round 2: K

Round 3: *K, YO, SK2P, YO, K, K-tbl, repeat from * around

Round 4: K

These four rounds form the pattern.

Work Little Arrow Head Lace pattern repeat 37 more times (38 times

total) (128 rounds)

Work rounds 1 and 2 once more.

Bind off loosely. Weave in ends. Block.
