


## BEANIE

## YARN

## Ella Rae LACE MERINO CHUNKY

## Col. No. Quantity x 100g Hanks 4 <br> 2

## MEASUREMENTS

To fit average sized adult head
Circumference approx 50 cm (193/4 in)

## NEEDLES

1 pair 5.00 mm needles (US 8)
1 pair 5.50 mm needles (US 9)

## TENSION/GAUGE

16 sts and 20 rows measured over 10 cm (approx 4 in ) of St st using 5.50 mm needles.

## Rib Pattern Repeat

Row 1 (RS) * P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1.
Row 2 (WS) K1 * yf, sl 1 wyif, yb, k1; rep from * to end.
These 2 rows form rib.

## BEANIE

Using 5.00 mm needles, cast on 92 sts.
Row 1 (RS) * K2, p2; rep from * to end.
Row 2 (WS) As row 1.
These 2 rows form rib.
Cont working in $2 \times 2$ rib until length measures 6 cm , ending on a WS row, inc 1 st on last row worked. [93 sts]

Change to 5.50 mm needles.
Cont working in Rib Pattern Repeat until length (incl band) measures 24 cm ending on a WS row. Shape Crown
(RS) Rib 5 * sl 1, k2tog, psso, rib 5; rep from * to end [71 sts]
Work 3 rows rib.
(RS) Rib 5 * sl 1, k2tog, psso, rib 3; rep from * to end. [49 sts]
Work 3 rows rib.
(RS) Rib 1 * sl 1, k2tog, psso, rib 1; rep from * to end. [25 sts]
Work 3 rows rib.
(RS) Rib 2 * sl 1, k2tog, psso; rep from * to last 2 sts, rib 2. [11 sts]
Break off yarn leaving enough length to sew seam.
Thread yarn through rem sts, pull tightly and secure. Sew seam.

## POMPOM

Cut two circles of cardboard, approx 6.5 cm in diameter (this will make a finished pompom of approx 4 cm ). Mark and cut out a small circle (approx 1.5 cm in diameter) in the centre of the two pieces. Wind the yarn around the cardboard until the centre hole is almost filled up. Using a pair of scissors, place the point between the two circles of cardboard and cut around keeping the scissors in between all the time. Using a double strand of yarn, wrap around between the two circles of cardboard, knot firmly and take away the cardboard. Trim the pompom to size.

SCARF

MEASUREMENTS
Width approx 20 cm (8 in)
Length 200 cm (79 in)
NEEDLES
1 pair 5.50 mm needles (US 10)
1 cable needle
TENSION/GAUGE
16 sts and 20 rows measured over 10 cm (approx 4 in ) of St st using 5.50 mm needles.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

C8F (Cable 8 front) slip the next 4 sts onto a cable needle and hold at front of work, k4 from left-hand needle, then $k$ the 4 sts from cable needle.

## Cable Pattern

Row 1 (RS) P4, k8, p4.
Row 2 K8, p4, k4.
Row 3 As row 1.
Row 4 As row 2.
Row 5 As row 1.
Row 6 As row 2.
Row 7 P4, C8F, p4.
Row 8 K4, p4, k8.
Row 9 As row 1.
Row 10 As row 8.
Row 11 As row 1.
Row 12 As row 8.
Row 13 As row 1.
Row 14 As row 8.
Row 15 As row 1.
Row 16 As row 8.
Row 17 As row 1.
Row 18 As row 8.
Row 19 As row 7 .
Row 20 As row 2.
Row 21 As row 1.
Row 22 As row 2.
Row 23 As row 1.
Row 24 As row 2.
These 24 rows form pattern repeat.
SCARF
Using 5.50mm needles, cast on 34 sts.
Establishment rows
Row 1 (RS) K9, work row 1 of Cable Panel, k9.
Row 2 (WS) K4, p5, work row 2 of Cable Panel, p5, k4.
These 2 rows set pattern.
Cont working in pattern as set until length measures approx 200 cm, ending on a Row 24 of pattern.
Cast off.

## Fringe

Cut lengths of yarn approx 40 cm long.
Using 4 strands together, fold in half.
Insert crochet hook just above cast on (or cast off) edge of scarf from back to front, catch the folded strands of yarn with hook and pull it through the knitting.
Insert the ends of yarn into loop and pull through
to tighten. Cont in this way until edge is sufficiently covered with fringe.
Repeat on other edge. Trim ends to even lengths.
