





YARN

Ella Rae LACE MERINO WORSTED

Col. No. Quantity x 100g Hanks #20 3

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference approx 62 cm (approx 24½ in) Length 37 cm (approx 14½ in)

NEEDLES

1 set 4.50mm circular needles (US 7) 2 x 4.00mm double pointed needles (US 6) stitch marker

TENSION/GAUGE

20 sts and 24 rnds measured over 10 cm/4 in of St st using 4.50mm circular needles.

Rib Pattern Repeat

Rnd 1 Knit.

Rnd 2 Knit.

Rnd 3 Purl.

Rnd 4 Purl.

These 4 rnds form patt rep.

PONCHO

Using 4.50mm circular needles, cast on 124 sts, pm and join taking care not to twist sts. Cont working in Rib patt until length measures approx 25 cm, ending on a rnd 4 of patt.

Next rnd (dec) * K2tog, k2; rep from * to end.

[93 sts]
Cont working in patt until length measures
32 cm, ending on a rnd 4.

Next rnd (make eyelets) * K3, yf, k2tog; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3. Work a further 11 rnds. Cast off.

I-cord Using 2 dpn, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (RS) K3, do not turn, slide sts back to beg of row to work next row from RS, pull yarn tightly to close sts up.

Rep until length measures 80 cm.

Cast off.

Thread cord through eyelets and attach pompoms.

POMPOM

Cut two circles of cardboard, approx 6.5 cm in diameter (this will make a finished pompom of approx 4 cm). Mark and cut out a small circle (approx 1.5 cm in diameter) in the centre of the two pieces. Wind the yarn around the cardboard until the centre hole is almost filled up. Using a pair of scissors, place the point between the two circles of cardboard and cut around keeping the scissors in between all the time. Using a double strand of yarn, wrap around between the two circles of cardboard, knot firmly and take away the cardboard. Trim the pompom to size.
