



CLASS
BUTTONED WAISTCOAT



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SIZE

Italian size 44 = US size 10 (approx. Medium).

MATERIALS

- 7 50g balls of Lana Gatto **Class** shade #5231 Lavender.
- One pair size US 6 (4mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Cable needle.
- Size D-3 (3.25mm) crochet hook.
- Sewing needle.
- 6 buttons.

STITCHES

USING KNITTING NEEDLES:

Garner stitch

Stockinette stitch

Reverse Stockinette stitch

Tubular stitch (work on odd number of sts)

Row 1: k1, * wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, wyib, k1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, * k1, wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, wyib, rep from * to end. Rep these 2 rows.

Left-slanted Cable (work on 6 sts)

Row 1 (RS): k.

Row 2: p.

Row 3: 6 left crossed sts (slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work, k 3 sts, k 3 sts from cable needle).

Row 4: p.

Row 5: k.

Row 6: p.

Rep 1- 6 rows.

Right-slanted Cable (work on 6 sts)

Row 1 (RS): k.

Row 2: p.

Row 3: 6 right crossed sts (slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to back of work, k 3 sts, k 3 sts from cable needle).

Row 4: p.

Row 5: k.

Row 6: p.

Rep 1- 6 rows.

Right Lace Cable (work on 10 sts) See Pattern Chart.

Work all WS row as follows: k the k sts and p the yo and p sts.

Work rows 1-18, then repeat only 5-18 rows every time.

8 st Right Cable

Slip 4 sts to cable needle and hold to back of work, k 4 sts, k 4 sts from cable needle.

Left Lace Cable (work on 10 sts) See Pattern Chart.

Work all WS row as follows: k the k sts and p the yo and p sts.

Work rows 1-18, then repeat only 5-18 rows every time.

8 st Left Cable

Slip 4 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work, k 4 sts, k 4 sts from cable needle.

Fancy Pattern A

Work as follows: * Right Lace Cable (10 sts), Right-Slanted Cable (6 sts), rep from * ending with a Right Lace Cable (10 sts).

Fancy Pattern B

Work as follows: * Left Lace Cable (10 sts), Left-Slanted Cable (6 sts), rep from * ending with a Left Lace Cable (10 sts).

Fancy Pattern C

Work as follows: * Right-Slanted Cable (6 sts), Right Lace Cable (10 sts), rep from *.

USING CROCHET HOOK:

Chain stitch

Slip stitch

Single crochet

GAUGE

24 sts and 27 rows to 4in/10cm over Fancy Patterns using size US 6 (4mm) needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

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BACK

With size US 6 (4mm) needles, cast on 81 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st for border. Continue inc 11 sts evenly distributed on next row (there are 92 sts) and work as follows: 1 st in Garter st (selvedge), 90 sts in Fancy Pattern A, 1 st in Garter st (selvedge) until piece measures 23in/58cm from beg. Bind off all sts.

LEFT FRONT

With size US 6 (4mm) needles, cast on 49 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st for border. Continue inc 3 sts evenly distributed on next row (there are 52 sts) and work as follows: 1 st in Garter st (selvedge), 48 sts in Fancy Pattern B, 2 sts in reverse Stockinette st and 1 st in Garter st (selvedge) until piece measures 19in/49cm from beg. Shape neck.

Next row (WS): bind off 9 sts (neck edge), patt to end.

Cont to dec at neck edge every other row: 5 sts twice, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once. Work even until piece measures same as for Back. Bind off rem 27 sts for shoulder.

RIGHT FRONT

Work to correspond to Left Front, reversing shaping and working Fancy Pattern C instead of B.

FINISHING

LEFT FRONT BAND

Using crochet hook, with RS facing, beg at upper edge, join yarn with sl st, 1 ch (= 1 sc) and work a Single crochet row (86 sts) down opening edge of Left Front, turn and with WS facing, using size US 6 (4mm) needles pick up and k 87 sts (picking up 1 st in each sc st) up opening edge of Left Front, then work 8 rows in Garter st. Bind off all sts.

RIGHT FRONT BAND

Using crochet hook, with RS facing, beg at lower edge, join yarn with sl st, 1 ch (1 sc) and work a Single crochet row (86 sts) up opening edge of Right Front, turn and with WS facing, using size US 6 (4mm) needles pick up and k 87 sts (picking up 1 st in each sc st) down opening edge of Right Front, then work 3 rows in Garter st.

Next row (WS-buttonhole row): Rib 3 sts (p1, k1 p1), yarn round needle, p2 tog, * Rib 14 sts (k1, p1 - 7 times) yarn round needle, p2 tog, rep from * 4 times more, k1, p1.

Work other 4 rows in Garter st. Bind off all sts. Sew shoulder seams.

NECK EDGING

Using crochet hook, with RS facing, beg at Right Front Band edge, join yarn with sl st, 1 ch (1 sc) and work a Single crochet row (108 sts) all along neck edge, ending at Left Front Band edge, turn and with WS facing, using size US 6 (4mm) needles pick up and k 109 sts (picking up 1 st in each sc st), then work 8 rows in Garter st. Bind off all sts.

RIGHT SIDE EDGING

Using crochet hook, with RS facing, beg at right lower edge of Back, join yarn with sl st, 1 ch (1 sc) and work 75 sc up side edge of Back, 1 sc at shoulder seam and 76 sc down side edge of Right Front. Cut yarn and weave neatly on WS away from edge.

RIGHT ARMHOLE BAND

With RS facing, using size US 6 (4mm) needles pick up and k last 30 sts up Right Back side edge, pick up and k 1 st at shoulder seam and 30 sts down Right Front side edge. Work 3 rows in Garter st. Bind off all sts.

LEFT SIDE EDGING

Using crochet hook, with RS facing, beg at lower side edge of Left Front, join yarn with sl st, 1 ch (1 sc) and work 75 sc up side edge of Left Front, 1 sc at shoulder seam and 76 sc down left side edge of Back. Cut yarn and weave neatly on WS away from edge.

LEFT ARMHOLE BAND


With RS facing, using size US 6 (4mm) needles pick up and k last 30 sts up Left Front side edge, pick up and k 1 st at shoulder seam and 30 sts down Left Back side edge. Work 3 rows in Garter st. Bind off all sts.

Sew side and armhole seams in Mattress st. Sew on buttons 🐾





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
Left Lace Cable Chart

Key



Each square corresponds to 1 st and 1 row.

On even rows K the knit sts and P the yo and purl sts.
