Head & body:

Start: Magic ring with 6 sc (6)

- r1: 1 inc in each st (12)
- r2: *1 sc, 1 inc* (18)
- r3: *2 sc, 1 inc* (24)
- r4: *3 sc, 1 inc* (30)
- r5: *4 sc, 1 inc* (36)
- r6: *5 sc, 1 inc* (42)
- r7: *6 sc, 1 inc* (48)
- r8 to r18: 1 sc in each st (48)
- r19: *6 sc, 1 dec* (42)
- r20: *5 sc, 1 dec* (36)
- r21: *4 sc, 1 dec* (30)
- r22: *3 sc, 1 dec* (24)
- r23 to r24: 1 sc in each st (24)

 fill

- r25: 1 sc in each st (24)
- r26: *3 sc, 1 inc* (30)
- r27 to r37: 1 sc in each st (30)



- r38: 1 sc in each st (30)
- r39: *3 sc, 1 dec* (24)
- r40: *2 sc, 1 dec* (18)
- r41: *1 sc, 1 dec* (12)
- r42: *1 dec in each st* (6)
- fill and close



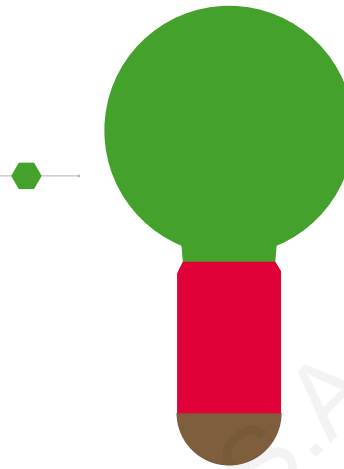


Face:

Using black yarn embroider the face. Add some creases and scars.

Final touch:

Stick a pair of pins or toothpicks in the monsters' temples as if they were two screws/bolts.



Arms (make 2 pieces):

Work 8 ch sts and close with a ss, making a ring.

r1 to r6: 1 sc in each st (8)

r7: 1 sc in each st (8)

r8: *2 sc, 1 dec* (6)

fill (optional)

close and sew one to each side of body.



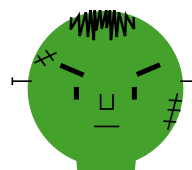
Legs (make 2 pieces):

Follow the same pattern as for the arms but using colours:



Hair:

Using black yarn embroider the hair; shorter and uneven at the front and longer at the back.



WITCH



Head & body:

Start: Magic ring with 6 sc (6)

r1: 1 inc in each st (12)

r2: *1 sc, 1 inc* (18)

r3: *2 sc, 1 inc* (24)

r4: *3 sc, 1 inc* (30)

r5: *4 sc, 1 inc* (36)

r6: *5 sc, 1 inc* (42)

r7: *6 sc, 1 inc* (48)

r8 to r18: 1 sc in each st (48)

r19: *6 sc, 1 dec* (42)

r20: *5 sc, 1 dec* (36)

r21: *4 sc, 1 dec* (30)

r22: *3 sc, 1 dec* (24)

r23 to r24: 1 sc in each st (24)

r25: 19 sc , 5 sc  (24)

r26: 20 sc , 3 sc , 1 sc  (24)

r27: 21 sc , 1 sc , 2 sc  (24)

 fill

r28: *3 sc, 1 inc* (30)

r29 to r32: 1 sc in each st (30)

close with a slip st and fill

 belt

r33: 1 sc in each st (30)

 skirt

r34: 1 sc in each st (30)

r35: sticking the hook in the yon/strand at front of stitch (exterior yon), *4 sc, 1 inc* (36)

r36: *5 sc, 1 inc* (42)

r37: *6 sc, 1 inc* (48)

close

Panties:

Return to row r35: sticking the hook in the yon/strand on the inside, *3 sc, 1 dec* (24)




r36: *2 sc, 1 dec* (18)

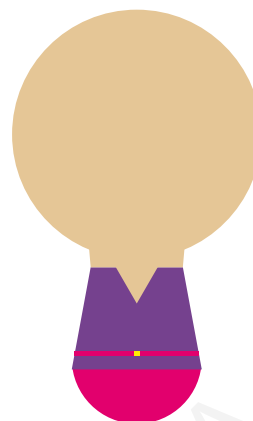
r37: *1 sc, 1 dec* (12)

r38: 1 dec in every sc (6)

fill and close.

Face:

   Embroider the face with red and black yarn.



Arms (make 2 pieces):

Work 8 ch sts and close with a ss, making a ring.

r1 to r6: 1 sc in each st (8)

r7: 1 sc in each st (8)

r8: *2 sc, 1 dec* (6)

fill (optional)

close and sew one to each side of body.



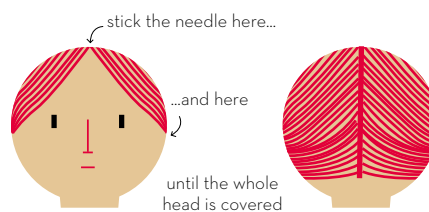
Legs (make 2 pieces):

Follow the same pattern as for the arms but using colours:



Hair:

Embroider hair with red yarn.

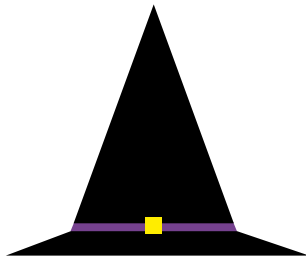


Make a chain that goes from the forehead to the neck to cover the sts.

To make the ponytail, roll a long strand of yarn over the fingers.



HAT



Start: Magic ring with 6 sc (6)

r1- r2: 1 sc in each st (6)

r3: *1 sc, 1 inc* (9)

r4: *1 sc in each st* (9)

r5: *2 sc, 1 inc* (12)

r6: *3 sc, 1 inc* (15)

r7: 1 sc in each st (15)

r8: *4 sc, 1 inc* (18)

r9: 1 sc in each st (18)

r10: *5 sc, 1 inc* (21)

r11: 1 sc in each st (21)

r12: *6 sc, 1 inc* (24)

r13: *7 sc, 1 inc* (27)

r14: sticking the hook in the yon/strand at front of stitch (exterior yon), *8 sc, 1 inc* (30)

r15: *4 sc, 1 inc* (36)

r16: *5 sc, 1 inc* (42)

r17: *6 sc, 1 inc* (48)

close

Final touch:

Embroider a little square in the centre of the belt simulating a buckle.

CAPE



Start: 27 chain sts

r1: 1 sc in each ch st (26)

r2: 1 dec, 22 sc, 1 dec (24)

r3: 1 dec, 20 sc, 1 dec (22)

r4 to v6: 1 sc in each st (22)

r7: 1 inc, 20 sc, 1 inc (24)

r8 to r22: 1 sc in each st (24)

r23: one row in ss (24)

close and sew to witch.

BROOMSTICK



Start: Magic ring with 8 sc (8).

r1 to r36: 1 sc in every st (8).

Fill.

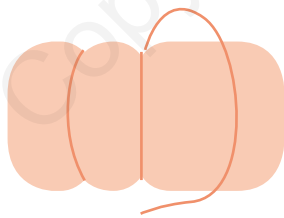
Cut a few strands of yarn approximately 2 1/4" (5 or 6 cm) long. Cut one more strand which is longer to wrap the strands around the "stick" of the broom taking advantage of the yarn to close the opening.

PUMPKIN



Start: Magic ring with 6 sc (6)
r1: 1 inc in each st (12)
r2: *1 sc, 1 inc* (18)
r3: *2 sc, 1 inc* (24)
r4: *3 sc, 1 inc* (30)
r5: *4 sc, 1 inc* (36)
r6: *5 sc, 1 inc* (42)
r7 to r13: 1 sc in each st (42)
r14: *5 sc, 1 dec* (36)
r15: *4 sc, 1 dec* (30)
r16: *3 sc, 1 dec* (24)
r17: *2 sc, 1 dec* (18)
fill
r18: *1 sc, 1 dec* (12)
r19: *1 dec in each sc* (6)

Finish filling and close leaving a yarn long enough to evenly wrap around the pumpkin 6 times pulling it firmly so it becomes puckered.



Face:

Finish by embroidering the pumpkin's face with black yarn.

CAULDRON



Start: Magic ring with 6 sc (6)
r1: 1 inc in each st (12)
r2: *1 sc, 1 inc* (18)
r3: *2 sc, 1 inc* (24)
r4: *3 sc, 1 inc* (30)
r5: *4 sc, 1 inc* (36)
r6 to r11: 1 sc in each st (36)
r12: *4 sc, 1 dec* (30)
r13: *3 sc, 1 dec* (24)
fill leaving some filling overflowing so it looks like steam from a potion.

Final touch:

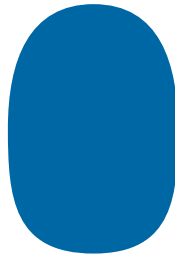
Thread a piece of brown yarn through the cauldron to simulate a pair of handles.

Stem:

Work 6 ch sts.
r1: 1 sc in each st (5)
Close and sew to upper part of pumpkin.



OWL



Body:

Start: Magic ring with 6 sc (6)

r1: 1 inc in each st (12)

r2: *1 sc, 1 inc* (18)

r3: *2 sc, 1 inc* (24)

r4: *3 sc, 1 inc* (30)

r5 to r16: 1 sc in each st (30)

r17: *3 sc, 1 dec* (24)

r18: *2 sc, 1 dec* (18)

fill

r19: *1 sc, 1 dec* (12)

r20: *1 dec in each sc* (6)

close.



Wings (make 2 pieces):

Work 8 ch sts

r1: 1 sc in each st (7), 1 ch st and turn work

r2: 6 sc, 1 ss

close and sew to both sides of body.

Tail:

Work 5 ch sts

r1 to r3: 1 sc in each st (4), 1 ch st and turn work

r4: 4 sc, close and sew to back of body.



Eyes (make 2 pieces):

Start: Magic ring with 6 sc (6)

r1: in hdc, 1 inc in each st (12)

close

1 row in ss for the inside of the eyes

embroider a second smaller circle in the centre
sew to body.

Beak:

Work 4 ch sts

r1: 1 sc in each st (3)

close and sew to body, between the eyes.
