

Relief pattern sweater

Size S and M

Figures for size M are given in (). One size only refers to both sizes.

Materials: Linie 226 Outland col 03 (green color) 550 (600) g, one pair size 5 – 6 mm needles, one spare

needle

Rib pattern: alt. K2, P2. Start with a return row, after edge st start with P1, then work alt. K2, P2.

Basic pattern: stockinette stitch = K on right side, P on wrong side.

Relief pattern: number of sts multiple of 20 + 18 sts. On return rows work sts as set. Rep rows 1 - 32.

Gauges:

(basic pattern) 18 sts and 22 rows to 4" square (rib pattern) 20 sts and 22 rows to 4" square (relief pattern) 22 sts and 22 rows to 4" square


METHOD


Back: cast on 90 (98) sts and work 14 cm or 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in rib pattern. For basic and relief pattern cont as foll: edge st, 15 (19) sts basic pattern, 58 sts relief pattern = patt g twice and sts 1 -18 of patt g once, 15 (19) sts basic pattern, edge st. Cont straight as given. When work measures 43 cm or 17" bind off for neck 28 center sts and cont for each side separately.

At neck edge dec on every alt row 2x 2 and 1x 1 st, then bind off rem 26 (30) shoulder sts.

Front: work as given for back except neck. When work measures approx. 40 cm or 15 $\frac{3}{4}$ " bind off 20 center sts and cont for each side separately. At neck edge bind off on every alt row 1x 4, 1x 3, 1x 2 and 1x 1 st. **Sleeves:** cast on 38 (46) sts and cont in rib pattern. For sleeve shaping inc 1 st at each end on every 8th row 15 times = 68 (86) sts. Work inc sts in rib pattern. When work measures 54 cm or 21 $\frac{1}{4}$ " from beginning bind off.

Finishing: join shoulder seams. For collar pick up from center front 96 sts (front neck 52 sts, back neck 44 sts) and work 2 cm or 13/16" in rounds in rib pattern, then divide work at center front and work another 12 cm or 4 ¾" in open rows. Bind off sts loosely. Sew sleeves in position, then join side and sleeve seams.

= slip 3 sts on cable needle and leave at front of work, P1, then K3 from cable needle

= slip 1 st on cable needle and leave at back of work, K3, then P1 from cable needle
