200 [200:300:300:400:400]g of Araucania Quemchi Shade 4.
1 Pair 3.25 mm (US3) knitting needles. 1 Pair 2.75 mm (US2) knitting needles. Stitch holders.

## TENSION

28sts and 36 rows to 10 cm , 4in, over stocking stitch using 3.25 mm (US3) knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Important Notes: Instructions are given for $71 / 76 \mathrm{~cm}, 28 / 30 \mathrm{in}$, larger sizes are given in square brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

## 2x2 Rib.

1st Row: *K2, P2, rep from * to last 2sts, K2.
2nd Row: P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end. Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

St-St. Stocking Stitch.
1st Row: Knit.
2nd Row: Purl.
Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

## Garter Stitch Pattern

1st Row: Knit.
2nd Row: Purl.
3rd Row: Knit.
4th Row: Purl.
5th Row: Knit.
6th Row: Knit.
Rep these 6 rows.

## DIRECTIONS

## BACK

Using 2.75mm (US2) needles cast on 114 [126:142:154:170:182]sts and work in 2x2 rib for $3 \mathrm{~cm}, 1 \frac{1}{4} \mathrm{in}$, ending with a rs row. Next Row: Rib to end inc 2sts evenly across row for 2nd, 4th and 6th sizes only. 114 [128:142:156:170:184]sts.
Change to 3.25 mm (US3) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until back measures $29 \mathrm{~cm}, 11 \frac{1}{2}$ in, ending with a ws row.

## Shape Armholes

Cast off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows.
100 [114:128:142:156:170]sts.
Work 6 [8:12:14:18:20] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.
88 [98:104:114:120:130]sts.
Work 7 [7:7:9:9:13] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row.
80 [90:96:104:110:116]sts.
Cont without shaping until armholes measure 14 [16:18:20:22:24]cm, $5^{1 ⁄ 2}$ [61/4:7: $8: 83 / 4: 91 / 2]$ in, ending with a ws row.

## Shape Neck

Next Row: K17 [20:23:25:28:29]sts, turn, leave rem 63 [70:73:79:82:87]sts on a stitch holder.
Working on these 17 [20:23:25:28:29]sts only proceed as follows:-
Next Row: Purl.
Work 7 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. 10 [13:16:18:21:22]sts.
Next Row: Purl.
Cast off.
With rs facing, working on rem 63 [70:73:
79:82:87]sts, slip first 46 [50:50:54:54:58]
sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 17 [20:23:25:28:29]sts and knit to end.
Next Row: Purl.
Work 7 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.
10 [13:16:18:21:22]sts.
Next Row: Purl.
Cast off.

## FRONT

Using 2.75mm (US2) needles cast on 114 [126:142:154:170:182]sts and work in $2 \times 2$
rib for $3 \mathrm{~cm}, 1 \frac{1}{4} / \mathrm{in}$, ending with a rs row.
Next Row: Rib to end inc 2sts evenly across row for 2nd, 4th and 6th sizes only. 114 [128:142:156:170:184]sts.
Change to 3.25 mm (US3) needles and proceed as follows:-
1st Row: K14 [18:23:27:32:37], *K5, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K24 [27:29:32:34:36]*, rep from * to * once, K5, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K19 [23:28:32:37:42].
2nd and Every Alt Row: Purl.
3rd Row: K14 [18:23:27:32:37], *K3, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K23 [26:28:31:33:35]*, rep from * to * once, K3, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K18 [22: 27:31:36:41].
5th Row: K14 [18:23:27:32:37], *K2, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K22 [25:27:30:32:34]*, rep from * to * once, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, s1,
K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K17 [21: 26:30:35:40].
7th Row: K14 [18:23:27:32:37], *K1, K2tog, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, s1, K1,
psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K21 [24:26:
29:31:33]*, rep from * to * once, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K16 [20:25: 29:34:39].
9th Row: K14 [18:23:27:32:37], *K2tog, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K20 [23:25: 28:30:32]*, K2tog, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K15 [19:24:28:33:38].
11th Row: K14 [18:23:27:32:37], *(K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso) twice, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K2tog, K19 [22:24: 27:29:31]*, rep from * to * once, (K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso) twice, yfwd, K2tog, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K2tog, K14 [18:23:27:32:37]. 13th Row: K14 [18:23:27:32:37], *K3, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K21 [24:26:29:31: 33]*, K3, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, K2, K2tog, yfwd, K16 [20:25:29:34:39].
15th Row: K14 [18:23:27:32:37], *K4, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K22 [25:27:30:32:34]*, rep from * to * once, K4, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K17 [21:26:30:35:40].
16th Row: Purl.
1st to 16th row sets patt.
Keeping continuity of patt as set cont until front measures $29 \mathrm{~cm}, 11 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{in}$, ending with a ws row.
Shape Armholes

Cast off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 100 [114:128:142:156:170]sts.
Work 6 [8:12:14:18:20] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.
88 [98:104:114:120:130]sts.
Commencing with 5th [1st:3rd:5th:1st:1st] row of garter stitch patt and working in patt (throughout) proceed as follows:-
Work 7 [7:7:9:9:13] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row.
80 [90:96:104:110:116]sts.
Work 1 [5:9:13:15:17] rows more without shaping.
Shape Neck
Next Row: Patt 23 [26:29:31:34:35]sts,
turn, leave rem 57 [64:67:73:76:81]sts on a stitch holder.
Working on these 23 [26:29:31:34:35]sts
only proceed as follows:-
Next Row: Patt.
Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.
19 [22:25:27:30:31]sts.
Work 10 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row.
14 [17:20:22:25:26]sts.
Work 13 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th row.
10 [13:16:18:21:22]sts.
Cont without shaping until armhole
measures same as back armhole, ending with a ws row.
Cast off.
With rs facing, working on rem 57 [64:67:
73:76:81]sts, slip first 34 [38:38:42:42:46] sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 23 [26:29:31:34:35]sts and patt to end.

## Next Row: Patt.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.
19 [22:25:27:30:31]sts.

Work 10 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row.
14 [17:20:22:25:26]sts.
Work 13 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th row.
10 [13:16:18:21:22]sts.
Cont without shaping until armhole measures same as back armhole, ending with a ws row.
Cast off.

## NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing,
using 2.75 mm (US2) needles pick up and knit 44sts evenly along left side of front neck, 34 [38:38:42:42:46]sts left on a stitch holder at front of neck, 44sts evenly along right side of front neck, 9sts evenly along right side of back neck, 46 [50:50:54:54: 58]sts left on a stitch holder at back of neck and 9sts evenly along left side of back neck.
186 [194:194:202:202:210]sts.
Next Row: Knit.
Commencing with 1st row of $2 \times 2$ rib work 8 rows.
Cast off in rib.

## ARMHOLE BORDERS (Both alike)

Join left shoulder and neckband seams. With rs facing, using 2.75 mm (US2) needles pick up and knit 118 [130:142:154: 166:178]sts evenly all round armhole edge.
Next Row: Knit.
Commencing with 1st row of $2 \times 2$ rib work 8 rows.
Cast off in rib.

## TO COMPLETE

Join side and armhole border seams.
See ball band for care instructions.
