# **MEASUREMENTS**

### To Fit Bust

## MATERIALS

100 [100:150:150:200:200]g of Araucania Lontue Shade 13.

- 1 Pair of 5mm (US8) knitting needles.
- 1 Pair of 4mm (US6) knitting needles. Stitch Holders.

## **TENSION**

17sts and 24 rows to 10cm, 4in over pattern using 5mm (US8) knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Important Notes: Instructions are given for 71/76cm, 28/30in, larger sizes are given in square brackets.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

alt alternate beginning beg centimetres cm continue. cont dec decrease(ing) foll following grammes g inch(es), in knit k mm millimetres

pass slipped stitch over psso

purl р pattern patt repeat rep remain(ing) rem rs right side

slip one stitch knitways s1

stitches st(s) together tog wrong side ws vfwd varn forward.

### **SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS**

1x1 Rib.

1st Row: \*K1, P1, rep from \* to last st,

2nd Row: P1, \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows. G-St. Garter Stitch. Every Row: Knit.

## **DIRECTIONS**

### **FRONT**

Using 4mm (US6) needles cast on 73 [83:89:99:107:117]sts and work 4 rows in a-st.

Change to 5mm (US8) needles and proceed as follows:-

1st Row: (K2, yfwd, s1, K1, psso) 0 [0: 0:0:0:1] times, K1 [0:3:2:0:1], K2tog, yfwd, \*K1, yfwd, s1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, rep from \* to last 4 [3:6:5: 3:2]sts, (K1, yfwd, s1, K1, psso) 1 [1:1: 1:1:0] times, K1 [0:3:2:0:2].

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: K0 [0:0:1:0:0], (K2tog, yfwd) 1 [0:0:1:0:0] times, K3 [4:1:3:4:3], vfwd, s1, K2tog, psso, vfwd, \*K3, vfwd, s1, K2tog, psso, yfwd, rep from \* to last 5 [4:1:6:4:3]sts, K3 [4:1:3:4:3], (yfwd, s1, K1, psso) 1 [0:0:1:0:0] times, K0 [0:0:1:0:0].

4th Row: Purl.

1st to 4th row sets patt.

Keeping continuity of patt as set (throughout) cont until Front measures 26cm, 101/4in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Next Row: Cast off 4 [5:5:5:5:5]sts in

patt at beg of next 2 rows. 65 [73:79:89:97:107]sts.

Work 2 [4:4:4:6:10] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

61 [65:71:81:85:87]sts.

Work 3 [3:5:11:11:9] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 57 [61:65:69:73:77]sts.\*\*

Cont without shaping until armholes

measure 5 [7:9:11:13:15:15]cm, 2 [23/4: 31/2:5:6:6]in,ending with a ws row.

Shape Neck

Next Row: Patt 20 [22:24:25:27:29]sts, turn, leave rem 37 [39:41:44:46:48]sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 20 [22:24:25:27:29] sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row: Patt.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.

16 [18:20:21:23:25]sts.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll alt row.

14 [16:18:19:21:23]sts.

Work 9 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th row.

11 [13:15:16:18:20]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 18 [20:22:24:26:28]cm, 7 [8:8½:9½:10:11]in, ending with a ws row

Cast off in patt.

Working on rem 37 [39:41:44:46:48] sts, slip 17 [17:17:19:19:19]sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 20 [22:24:25:27:29]sts and patt to end.

Next Row: Patt.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row.

16 [18:20:21:23:25]sts.

Work 4 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll alt row.

14 [16:18:19:21:23]sts.

Work 9 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th row.

11 [13:15:16:18:20]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 18 [20:22:24:26:28]cm, 7 [8: 8½:9½:10:11]in, ending with a ws row Cast off in patt.

### **BACK**

Work exactly as given for Front until \*\* is reached.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 18 [20:22:24:26:28]cm, 7 [8: 8½:9½:10:11]in, ending with a ws row. Cast off.

### **NECK EDGING**

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, using 4mm (US6) needles pick up and knit 26sts evenly along left side of neck, knit across 17 [17:17:19:19: 19]sts left on a stitch holder at front of

neck, pick up and knit 26sts evenly along right side of neck and 35 [35:35: 37:37:37]sts from cast off sts at back of neck.

104 [104:104:108:108:108]sts.

Work 4 rows in g-st. Cast off knitways.

## ARMHOLE BORDERS (Both alike)

Join left shoulder and Neckband seams.

With rs facing, using 4mm (US6) needles pick up and knit 91 [99:107: 115:123:131]sts evenly all round armhole edge.


Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 6 rows.

Cast off in rib.

### TO COMPLETE

Join side and armhole border seams. See ball band for care instructions.
