NEEDLES

- 1 pair 4.00mm needles (US 6)
- 1 pair 4.50mm needles (US 7)
- 1 cable needle

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS 6 small buttons

TENSION/GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows measured over 10cm (approx 4") of St st using 4.50mm needles.

Special Abbreviations

C2R (Cross 2 right) K into front of second st on left-hand needle, then k into front of first st, drop both sts off needle tog.

C4B (Cable 4 back) Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k next 2 sts on left-hand needle, then k 2 sts on cable needle.

CABLE CARDIGAN

BACK

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 86(96,106,118) sts.

Work in k1, p1 rib for 18 rows.

Change to 4.50mm needles.

Establishment rows:

Row 1 Size A P1, * C2R, p2, k1, p2, k4, p2, k1, p2, C2R, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k4, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R *, p1.

Size B P3, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p3.

Size C P4, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p4.

Size D P4, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p4.

Row 2 Size A K1, * p2, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p2, k1.

Size B K3, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k3.

Size C K4, p2, k2, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k2, p2, k4.

Size D K4, p1, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, p1, k4.

Row 3 Size A P1, * C2R, p2, k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2

Size B K3, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k3.

Size C P4, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p4.

Size D P4, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p4.

Row 4 Size A K1, * p2, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p2 *, k1.

Size B K3, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k3.

Size C K4, p2, k2, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k2, p2, k4.

Size D K4, p1, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, p1, k4.

Size B P3, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p3.

Size C P4, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p4.

Size D P4, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p4.

Row 6 As row 4.

k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p2, C2R, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R *, p1.

Size B P3, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p3.

Size C P4, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p4.

Size D P4, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p4.

Row 8 As row 2.

Row 9 As row 5.

Row 10 As row 4.

Row 11 As row 3.

Row 12 As row 4.

These 12 rows form pattern repeat.

Cont working in pattern repeat until length (incl band) measures 34 cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape armholes (RS) Cast off 2(2,4,4) sts at beg next 2 rows. [82(92,102,110) sts]

Next row(RS)(dec) Dec 1 st each end next row, then 1 st each end foll alt rows, 4 times. [72(82,92,100) sts]

Cont working straight until length (incl band) measures 54(55,56,57) cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulders and back neck (RS) Cast off 5(6,7,9) sts, patt 25(29,31,34) sts, turn, leave rem sts on a holder.

(WS) Cast off 8 sts, patt to end.

(RS) Cast off 5(6,7,9) sts, patt to end.

(WS) Cast off 8 sts, patt to end.

(RS) Cast off rem sts.

With RS facing, cast off 12 sts, patt to end.

(WS) Cast off 5(6,7,9) sts, patt to end.

(RS) Cast off 8 sts, patt to end.

(WS) Cast off 5(6,7,9) sts, patt to end.

(RS) Cast off 8 sts, patt to end.

(WS) Cast off rem sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 45(50,55,61) sts.

Row 1 K3, * p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 * K1, p1; rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 3 Buttonhole row K2tog, yon, k1, * p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep rows 1 and 2, 6 times more, then row 2 again.

Row 17 Buttonhole row Work as for row 3.

Row 18 As row 2.

Change to 4.50mm needles.

Establishment rows:

Row 1 Size A * K3, p1, C2R, p2, C2R, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k4, p2, k1, p2, C2R, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p1.

Size B Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p3. Size C Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p4.

Size D Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p4.

Row 2 Size A K1, * p2, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p2, k1, p3 *.

Size B P1, k2, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *

Size C K4, p2, k2, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *.

Size D K4, p1, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, work

as for size A from * to *.

Row 3 Size A * K3, p1, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R *, p1.

Size B Work as for size A from * to * , k2, p1, k3.

Size C Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p4.

Size D Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p4.

Row 4 Size A K1, * p2, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p2, k1, p3 *.

Size B P1, k2, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to * .

Size C K4, p2, k2, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *.

Size D K4, p1, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, work as for size A from * to *.

Row 5 Size A * K3, p1, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, p2, k4, p2, k1, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, k1, p2, k2, p2

Size B Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p3.

Size C Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p4.

Size D Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p4.

Row 6 As row 4.

Row 7 Size A * K3, p1, C2R, p2, C2R, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p2, C2R, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R *, p1.

Size B Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p3.

Size C Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p4.

Size D Work as for size A from * to *, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p4.

Row 8 As row 2.

Row 9 As row 5.

Row 10 As row 4.

Row 11 As row 3.

Row 12 As row 4.

These 12 rows form pattern repeat.

Work in patt rep AT THE SAME TIME cont to make buttonholes as before on every 15th row, 4 times more.

Cont working in patt rep until length (incl band) measures same as back to armholes, ending on a RS row.

Shape armhole (WS) Cast off 2(2,4,4) sts at beg next row. [43(48,51,57) sts] (RS) Dec 1 st at end next row, then on foll alt rows 4 times. [38(43,46,52) sts] Cont working straight until length (incl band) measures 43 cm, ending on a WS row. Shape neck (RS) Cast off 3 sts at beg next row, then on foll alt rows 5 times

next row, then on foll alt rows 5 times. [20(25,28,34) sts]

Pattern 1 row.

(RS) Dec 1 st at beg next row, then on foll alt rows, 5 times. [14(19,22,28) sts] Cont working straight until length measures same as back to sh sh, ending on a RS row.

Shape shoulder (WS) Cast off 5(6,7,9) sts at beg next row, then on foll alt row, once. Pattern 1 row.

Cast off rem 4(7,8,10) sts.

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 45(50,55,61) sts.

Row 1 * K1, p1; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3. Row 2 P3, * k1, p1; rep from * to end. Rep rows 1 and 2, 8 times more.

Change to 4.50mm needles. Establishment rows:

Row 1 Size A P1,* C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k4, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, C2R, p1, k3 *.

Size B P3, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *

Size C P4, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *.

Size D P4, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *.

Row 2 Size A * P3, k1, p2, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p2 *, k1.

Size B Work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k2, p1.

Size C Work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k2, p2, k4.

Size D Work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, p1, k4.

Row 3 Size A P1 * C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p1, k3 *.

Size B P3, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *.

Size C P4, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *.

Size D P4, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *.

Row 4 Size A * P3, k1, p2, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p2 *, k1.

Size B Work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k2, p1.

Size C Work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k2, p2, k4.

Size D Work as for size A from * to *, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2, p1, k4.

Row 5 Size A P1,* C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k4, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p1, k3 *.

Size B P3, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *.

Size C P4, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *.

Size D P4, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *.

Row 6 As row 4.

Row 7 Size A P1, * C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, C2R, C2R, p2, C2R, p1, k3 *.

Size B P3, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *.

Size C P4, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *.

Size D P4, k1, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2, k1, p2, work as for size A from * to *

Row 8 As row 2.

Row 9 As row 5.

Row 10 As row 4.

Row 11 As row 3.

Row 12 As row 4.

These 12 rows form pattern repeat.

Cont working in patt rep until length (incl band) measures same as back to armholes, ending on a WS row.

Shape armhole (RS) Cast off 2(2,4,4) sts at beg next row. [43(48,51,57) sts]

(WS) Dec 1 st end next row, then on foll alt rows 4 times. [38(43,46,52) sts]

Cont working straight until length (incl band) measures 43 cm, ending on a RS row.

Shape neck (RS) Cast off 3 sts at beg next row, then on foll alt rows 5 times. [20(25,28,34) sts]

Pattern 1 row.

(WS) Dec 1 st at beg next row, then on foll alt rows, 5 times. [14(19,22,28) sts]
Cont working straight until length measures

same as back to sh sh, ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulder (RS) Cast off 5(6,7,9) sts at beg next row, then on foll alt row, once. Pattern 1 row.

Cast off rem 4(7,8,10) sts.

SLEEVES

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 44 sts. Establishment rows:

Row 1 P1, * k1, p2, k4, p2, k1, p2, C2R, p2; rep from * once more, k1, p2, k4, p2, k1, p1.

Row 2 K1, * p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k2, p2, k2; rep from * once more, p1, k2, p4, k2, p1, k1. Row 3 P1, * k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p2, C4B, p2; rep from * once more, k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p1.

Row 4 As row 2.

These 4 rows form patt rep.

Note Work inc's into patt by adding k1, p2 rep's to each end of RS rows. Cont working in patt rep as set AT THE

SAME TIME shape sides as foll: Inc 1 st each end 10th row, then 1 st each end every foll 6th row, 10 times, then 1 st each end foll 6th row 1(2,3,4) times.

[68(70,72,74) sts]

Cont working straight until length measures 46 cm, ending on a Ws row.

Shape top (RS) Cast off 2 sts at beg next 2 rows. [64(66,68,70) sts]

Next row(RS)(dec) Dec 1 st each end next 5 rows, then dec 1 st each end foll alt rows, 7(7,8,8) times.

Patt 1 row.

(RS) Cast off 2 sts at beg next 6 rows. Cast off rem 28 sts.

MAKING UP

Using a warm iron over a damp cloth, press pieces gently.

With RS tog, sew shoulder seams using backstitch.

Sew side seams.

Sew sleeve seams and set into armhole, sew into place.

Collar Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 130 sts.

Row 1 K1, yon, k2tog, * k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 K2tog, rib to last 2 sts, k2tog. Cont working in k1, p1 rib, AT THE SAME TIME dec 1 st each end every row, 13 times more, then 1 st each end every alt row, 8 times. (86 sts)

Cast off in rib.

Sew shaped edge of collar to neck edge.

LEFT FRONT
