fingerless mitts By Adrienne Ku

A lacy fingerless mitt with a scalloped edge and ribbed cubf. Simple increases and decreases create the scalloped cast-on edge. The hand is worked in a simple lace pattern and the top is finished with 1 x 1 rib.


## SIZE

S (L) (Shown in size S )

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference 7.75 (9.5)" / 19.5 (24) cm

## YARN

1 ball Juniper Moon Farm Findley in color \#29 Greengage

## NEEDLES

US 2 ( 2.75 mm ) double-point needles, or size used to obtain gauge

## NOTIONS

Tapestry needle, stitch markers, scrap yarn/stitch holder

## GAUGE

30 sts and 42 rows $=4 " / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in St st in the round.
25.5 sts and 52 rows $=4 " / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in lace patt after blocking.

## FINGERLESS MITT (make 2)

## Cuff

CO 84 (96) sts and join for working in the round, pm to indicate end of rnd.

Rnd 1: K.
Rnd 2: K.
Rnd 3: *K2tog twice, kfb four times, ssk twice; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 4: K.
Rnd 5: *K2tog twice, k 4 , ssk twice; rep from * to end of rnd - 56 (64) sts.

Rnd 6: K.
Rnd 7: P.
Rnd 8: K.
Rnd 9: K1, *p2, k2; rep to 3 st before end of rnd, p2, k1.
Work Rnd 9 nineteen more times.
Size $S$ only: Rnd 10: K2tog, k26, k2tog, $k$ to end of rnd - 54 sts.
Size L only: Rnd 10: K to end of rnd.
Both sizes:
Rnd 11: P to end of rnd.
Rnd 12: K to end of rnd.

## Hand - Thumb Gusset

Rnd 1: K4, pm to indicate end of gusset, *work Row 1 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 2: K.
Rnd 3: Kfb twice, k2, *work Row 2 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd - 56 (66) sts.

Rnd 4: K.
Rnd 5: K to m,* work Row 3 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 6: Kfb , k to 3 sts before $\mathrm{m}, \mathrm{kfb}, \mathrm{k}$ to end of rnd - 58 (68) sts.
Rnd 7: K to m, *work Row 4 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 8: K.
Rnd 9: Kfb, k to 3 sts before m, kfb, k2, *work Row 5 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd - $60(70)$ sts.
Rnd 10: K.
Rnd 11: K to m, *work Row 6 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 12: Kfb , k to 3 sts before $\mathrm{m}, \mathrm{kfb}$, k to end of rnd - 62 (72) sts.
Rnd 13: K to m, *work Row 7 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 14: K.
Rnd 15: Kfb, k to 3 sts before m, kfb, k2, *work Row 8 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd - 64 (74) sts.
Rnd 16: K.
Rnd 17: K to m, *work Row 1 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 18: Kfb , k to 3 sts before $\mathrm{m}, \mathrm{kfb}$, k to end of rnd -66 (76) sts.
Rnd 19: K to m , *work Row 2 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 20: K.
Rnd 21: Kfb, k to 3 sts before m, kfb, k2, *work Row 3 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd - 68 (78) sts.
Rnd 22: K.
Rnd 23: K to m, *work Row 4 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 24: Kfb , k to 3 sts before m , kfb , k to end of rnd -70 (80) sts.
Rnd 25: K to m, *work Row 5 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 26: K.
Rnd 27: Kfb, k to 3 sts before m, kfb, k2, * work Row 6 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd - 72 (82) sts.

Rnd 28: K.
Rnd 29: K to m, *work Row 7 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 30: Kfb , k to 3 sts before m , kfb , k to end of rnd - 74 (84) sts.
Rnd 31: K to m, *work Row 8 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 32: K.
Size L only:
Rnd 33: Kfb, k to 3 sts before m, kfb, k2, *work Row 1 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd - 86 sts.
Rnd 34: K.
Rnd 35: K to m, ${ }^{*}$ work Row 2 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 36: Kfb, k to 3 sts before $\mathrm{m}, \mathrm{kfb}$, k to end of rnd -88 sts .
Rnd 37: K to m, *work Row 3 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 38: K.
Both sizes:
Next Rnd: K1, sl next 21 (25) sts onto st holder or scrap of yarn, CO 1 st, k2, *work Row 1 (Row 4) of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd - 54 (64) sts.

## Hand - After Gusset

Rnd 1: K.
Rnd 2: K to m, *work Row 2 (Row 5) of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 3: K2, k2tog, k to 1 st before end of rnd, sl 1 purlwise, remove m , sl next st purlwise, knit these two sts together through the back loop, pm to indicate new end of rnd. - 52 (62) sts.
Rnd 4: K to m, *work Row 3 (Row 6) of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 5: K2tog, k to 1 st before end of rnd, sl 1 purlwise, remove m , sl next st purlwise, knit these two sts together through the back loop, existing $m$ indicates new end of rnd. - 50 (60) sts.
Rnd 6: *Work Row 4 (Row 7) of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 7: K.
Rnd 8: *Work Row 5 (Row 8) of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.

## Rnd 9: K.

Rnd 10: *Work Row 6 (Row 1) of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 11: K.
Rnd 12: *Work Row 7 (Row 2) of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 13: K.
Rnd 14: *Work Row 8 (Row 3) of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.

## Rnd 15: K.

Size L only:
Rnd 16: *Work Row 4 of Chart A; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rnd 17: K.
Both sizes: Work in k 1 , pl rib for 10 rnds.

BO in $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{pl}$ rib.
Cut yarn leaving a 6-8" / 15-20 cm long tail and draw through last st.

## Thumb

Pick up and knit one st in CO st at base of thumb, k 21 (25) held sts, join for working in the round, pm to indicate end of rnd - 22 (26) sts.

Knit 8 (10) rnds.
Work in k 1 , pl rib for 4 rnds.
BO in $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{pl}$ rib.
Cut yarn leaving a $6-8^{\prime \prime} / 15-20 \mathrm{~cm}$ long tail and draw through last st.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends, block lightly.
